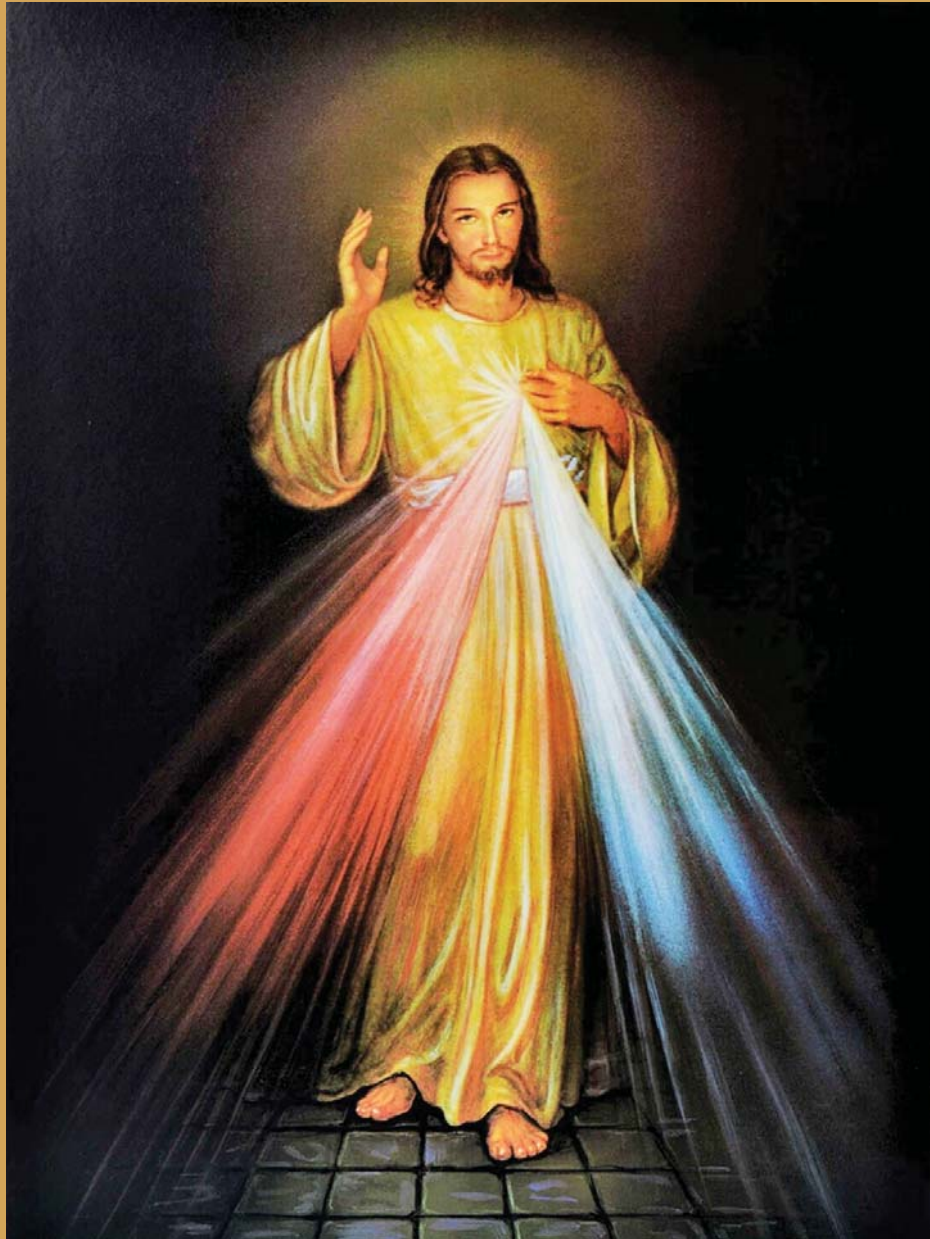

.. *Have Mercy on Us and on the Whole World* ..

There's a beautiful and urgent prayer that the prophet Habakkuk makes, preserved for us in the Old Testament. It's an appeal for God to make His presence known to people of the prophet's own day, as God had worked in the ages past. "In the midst of the years make it known," he cries; "in Your wrath remember mercy." Habakkuk then continues with a vivid image of God's glory: "His brightness was like the light, rays flashed from His Hand, and there He veiled His power."

Every time I pray with this passage of Scripture I can't help conjuring in my mind's eye the Divine Mercy portrait. For those of you unfamiliar with it, we have a handsome framed copy of it in the side chapel at St. Ann. (And I'm sure Kat also will include a thumbnail of it at the bottom of this column, as she always does with my articles.)

The image was revealed to the Polish mystic Sister Maria Faustina Kowalska—known to us today as St. Faustina—in February of 1931. She records in her diary that Christ Himself appeared to her in her cell at the convent and told her she should have the portrait painted "according to the pattern you see." The painting shows two rays shining forth from Christ's chest, with His Hand touching the place where the rays come from. One ray is a pale blue; the other red.

As I mentioned, the nearness of His left Hand to the rays' point of origin recalls the prayer from Habakkuk. Similarly, Christ's instruction to Faustina to re-create the image according to the pattern she saw echoes God's command to Moses in Exodus, to carefully construct the Ark of the Covenant according to the pattern shown him on Mount Sinai. Thus, there is a deep connection between the painting and its commissioning with the biblical Word of God.

The dual-colored rays are meant to symbolize the blood and water that flowed from our Lord's side as He hung dead on the cross, when the soldier pierced Him with the lance. "The pale ray stands for the Water that makes souls righteous," Jesus explained to Faustina in her prayer; "The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls." So, the portrait also refers us back to the two great saving sacraments—the waters of baptism and the Precious Blood of the Eucharist.

Perhaps the most famous image of Jesus today, the painting of the Merciful Jesus was revealed to this cloistered Polish nun at the beginning of a decade that would end with her homeland being invaded jointly by Nazi Germany, the Soviet Union, and the Slovak Republic in 1939, which would prove to be the catalyst of World War II. At the dawn of this horrific period of history—marked by state-of-the-art warfare, unimaginable genocide, and ultimately the invention of nuclear weaponry—the Lord Jesus was already at work in a hidden pocket of His world to renew His ever-faithful promise of mercy. Today, celebrated by the whole Catholic Church as Divine Mercy Sunday, reminds us that God does answer Habakkuk's prayer: *In the midst of the years renew it; in the midst of the years make it known; in wrath remember mercy.* In the midst of war-torn years, in the midst of our own tumultuous years, our God renews His work and makes it known. He remembers mercy.

PEACE FLIGHT

On Good Friday NPR carried an hour program with an Audubon Society official that chronicled steep declines in bird populations across the United States. It also played listeners' audio files of favorite species singing that were once common sounds in their childhood. Now it takes time and effort to record them. And it had been so easy to earn my girl scout badge in the woods and fields of the Paine estate across from St. Ann's. Of course, it's still fun to welcome some local birds back. On early morning walks, I keep an eye out for worms to fuel the robins.

By noon reports that an F-15 jet had been shot down were accompanied by file footage of sleek planes taking off. Contrast that image with the "Peace Dove" that reflects the Holy Spirit. It descended on Jesus at His baptism (Mt 3:16). The risen Jesus bestowed it on his disciples (Jn 20:22) and every baptized Christian receives that gift of the Spirit. Suppose a seasonal "bird count" in the Middle East logged two species: (i) the war planes (and drones) and (ii) Spirit-inspired humans. What sound recordings belong to each species? Are the noises of war drowning out those of the peacemakers, humanitarian aid groups, and even religious celebrations of Passover and Easter?

Add to that prayer services in our Department of War celebrating the "Lord of Hosts", reading Ps 144:1 and Jeremiah 50:3 as a Bible mash up against the biblical truth: God's power delivers his oppressed, suffering people. So, it seems that the "peace doves" are heading for extinction. Today's readings provide hints about where those rare birds are nesting. Acts 2:42-47 depicts the tiny group of Jesus' followers inventing a community that cares for each person's needs and gathered daily for prayer. 1 Peter 1:3-9 reminds Christians given "...a new birth to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus ... kept in heaven for you by the power of God..." not to be discouraged by statistics. Present sufferings prove genuine faith.

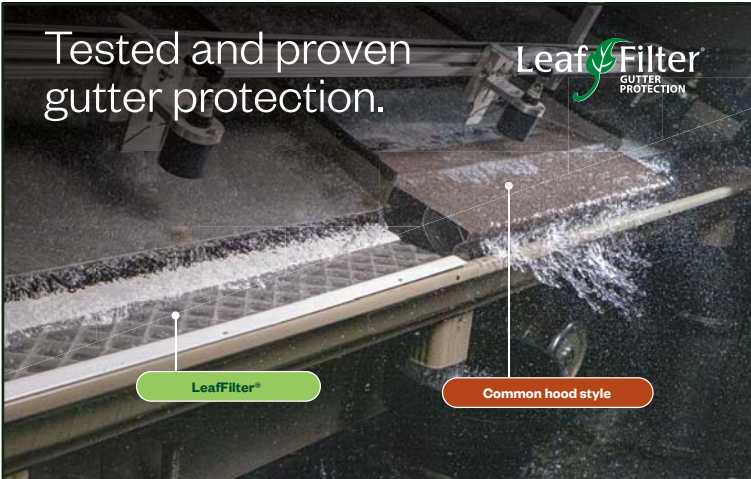

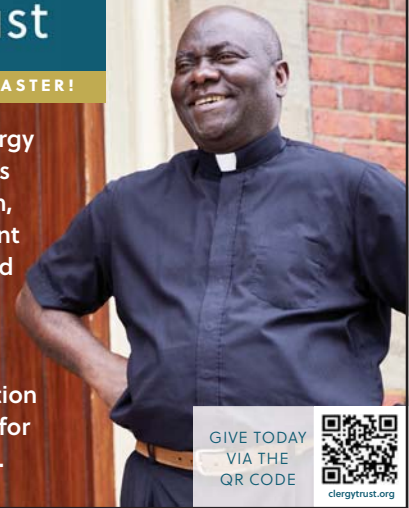

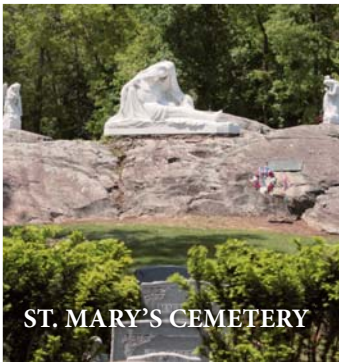
