In Illo Uno Unum (Part I) . . .

Pope Leo XIV's motto translates into English as "In the One, we are one." The "One," of course, is our Lord Jesus Christ; the phrase hearkens back to the apostle Paul's letter to the Romans: "we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another."

It's a pretty sounding notion, to be sure. But taken seriously (and I believe the holy father does take it seriously) it in fact is a massive challenge to undertake. And an imperative one. Because it means nothing less than to make the Church the Church: to reclaim what the Church is meant to be, and without this unity rooted in Christ, it won't be the Church at all.

What makes it such a massive challenge is that, while such unity indeed does sound nice to us, what is required from us to form this unity is something we're quite reluctant to take on. Namely, the surrender of our individualism. Please note carefully this word I just used—I didn't say we surrender our *individuality*, but our *individualism*. We are many, as St. Paul recognizes, and that uniqueness that makes us many is part of the dignity that each person has. But that individuality too easily can splinter off into individualism: the construction of an independent identity based entirely on one's own uniqueness without thought to our duty to the greater order.

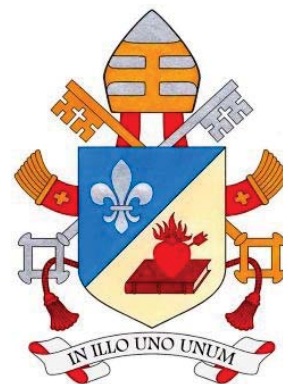
Harvard University political scientist Robert Putnam has made a career of the study of social capital—the values and sense of commonwealth that bind people together into a community; and most particularly, Putnam has focused on the decline in social capital that has come to characterize recent culture. Any shared idea of a common "us" has disintegrated, and the bonds of social cohesion have consequently weakened or even dissolved.

Partly, this is because to think of oneself as being part of an "us" can carry with it the underlying presumption of a "them," which in turn suggests a

certain enmity: "us" vs. "them." However, the adversarial element doesn't have to be the case. We can develop an open "us" that is defined by common values and a shared worldview freely undertaken by the members, without animosity to others. In fact, this is necessary to create a genuine community. A vague, universalized, vanilla "us" such as one-world vision is too broad and nondescript to be of any use in forging authentic bonds of trust, good-will, and empathetic identification. Ironically, it fosters individualism, hollowing out any sentimental gesture of openness to a blasé "you-do-you-I'll-do-me" mindset. Neighbors who only wave to each other over the fence while mowing their lawns aren't neighbors in any meaningful way. (Putnam actually identified that in ethnically/culturally diverse neighborhoods, the tendency to isolate—even from neighbors of one's own group—is greatest.)

The Church, on the other hand, as the living sign of Christ's continued presence in the world throughout history, has the specific mission of bringing about communion among the human family. Patterning our lives on the life of Christ Himself, modeling His obedience to the Father, His fidelity to the divine plan for creation, and by extending His work of reaching out to those on the periphery in order to bring them in, Christians are called to take up the massive challenge—each according to one's own state in life—of strengthening this communion, so that as we grow in the likeness of our Lord, we all indeed do become one in the One.

FEELING IT

Archaeologists cannot locate Emmaus, but 7 miles is a half-day hike in hilly terrain. How far into that sad trip home do you imagine Cleopas and his friend were before a stranger broke into their conversation (Lk 24:13-35)? Luke has Cleopas summarize the news feed from Good Friday to an unconfirmed Easter morning report, “Jesus lives”. So, embers of hope that Jesus was God’s chosen must remain in their hearts. It’s the stranger’s turn to give them the lesson that he had tried to drill into the Twelve in weeks leading up to his death. God’s messiah was to suffer as prophesied (e.g. Isa 52:13-53:12). Hope warming up.

No recognition, yet. Hospitality to the stranger takes center stage. At that meal Jesus finally reveals himself. Their hopes have not been disappointed ... or even delayed. As Luke tells the story, God kept them from recognizing the stranger, “their eyes were prevented from recognizing him,” “their eyes were opened” ... Instead, the story unfolds a wealth of emotions: hopes aroused by Jesus’ ministry, shocking violence from officials, grief, then a puzzle – has God got another way to salvation planned?? (In the Acts of the Apostles Christians call their movement “the Way”).

Looking back with open eyes, the disciples remember their feelings as Jesus, “*beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted what referred to him in all the Scriptures.*” Those embers of hope were fanned into flames. Those verses reflect how Christians are to read Moses and the prophets as the story of God’s salvation leading to Christ. The goal is not academic scholarship, but sustaining believers’ hope. Catholics recognize that Scripture is Part I of Finding Jesus. The Meal scene is Part II: “*took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them.*” With that recognition, the stranger whom the disciples had welcomed with generous hospitality vanishes. But the disciples now have faith in the angels’ message that Jesus lives. Every Eucharistic celebration is “feeling it” with the heart for hope, hospitality (love), and faith.
