## *O Most Holy Trinity Undivided Unity . . .*

When I was in high school I used to listen to the country-music singer/songwriter Tom T. Hall. On his Greatest Hits album there's a tune called "Me and Jesus," the chorus of which goes:

*Me and Jesus, we got our own thing goin'  
Me and Jesus, we got it all worked out  
Me and Jesus, we got our own thing goin'  
We don't need anybody to tell us what it's all about*

While his record label may call it one of his greatest hits, it's never been one of my favorites. I have to admit, it's a catchy little toe-tapper, but with all due respect: Mr. Hall *does* need somebody to tell him what it's all about.

No one's relationship with God is an insulated private matter between himself and the Lord. Christianity defies this sort of exclusivity; our faith has always been catholic in the original sense of the word, which, we'll remember, means "universal." We can't have "our own thing goin'" with Jesus, independent of anyone else's input or impact. We can't be closed in on ourselves like that, for one primary reason: God Himself isn't so closed in.

The full revelation of the Christian Faith is that God exists as Trinity: one God in three Persons. So to settle into an exclusive relationship just with Jesus leaves out the fact that Christ never comes to us on His own; He always bears in Him the love of the Father, and we can only really draw near to Christ through the inspiration and guidance of the Holy Spirit. Leave out any one of the three Divine Persons and you don't have any of them.

This is worth deep reflection. God, the Architect and Artisan of all reality, is in His very essence a dynamic relationship. This means all reality bears the stamp of the Triune God Who created it — reality itself is Trinitarian. So the fullest participation in reality is a communal participation, and the purest participation in our faith-life is equally communal. By faith we are drawn in to share in the inner-life of the Blessed Trinity, and by faith we are caught up in the lives of our fellow Christians. And this same faith summons us to stretch out to others and gather them into this common sharing of the Blessed Trinity's inner life. This is the supreme mystery of the Church and her Faith, a mystery that deserves to be contemplated. It's also the supreme action of the Church, an action that needs to be the pattern of our own actions as Christians.

The Catholic Church has designated the Sunday after Pentecost every year as Trinity Sunday. This tradition, which dates as far back as the eighth century, is an eloquent, living testament to the reality of our Trinitarian faith. The whole Church throughout the world gathers today in communal worship of the one God in three Persons. The multitude of voices of so many believers join today in the one hymn of praise. The harmony of this symphony bears witness to the rich reality of the heavenly harmony of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Today we remind ourselves that our faith isn't just me and Jesus. It's me, and Jesus, and the Father, and the Holy Spirit—and the whole Church together.

## SOMETHING TO LOVE

John 3:16, “*God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life,*” regularly appears on fan placards in sports venues. How many viewers could recite the whole verse, or the verses which follow it in today’s gospel? There is an ominous undertone. Even though God has reached out in making the ultimate self-sacrifice of His only, beloved Son, human beings still have freedom to walk away. Doing so is the path to death. Read the Bible carefully beginning with the first story of human disobedience in Genesis 3, and you will find that even though humans repeatedly fail in spectacular ways, God never redesigns the model!

Today’s first reading recalls another collapse, rejecting the deity who had freed them from slavery in Egypt to worship a golden-calf idol while Moses was with God on Sinai receiving the commandments. Enraged at that breach of faith, Moses had smashed the original tablets. Now the Lord will inscribe new ones (Exod 34:4-9). God identifies as “... *a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity.*” Desired traits for humans, not just gods! But that is not reliable for them. Instead, Moses asks God to stick it out with the flawed model, “... *a stiff-necked people; yet pardon our wickedness ... and receive us as your own.*”

As today’s celebration of the peculiarly Christian teaching that God is One in Three distinct persons of Father, Son and Spirit reminds us love circulates at the core of divine being – even before creation. St. Augustine notes that while the Son represents unity as equality, the “Holy Spirit a harmony of unity and equality,” (*Christian Teaching* i, 10-12). That harmony repeatedly eluded the church in Corinth where Paul concludes his letter, “...*live in peace and the God of love and peace will be with you,*” (2 Cor 13:12).
