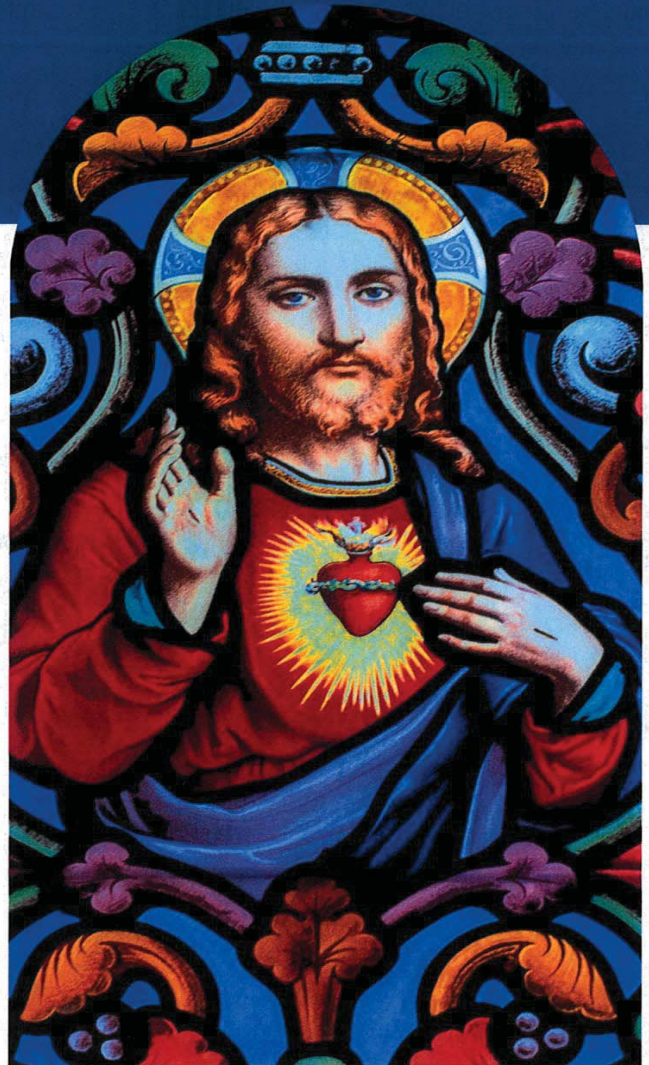

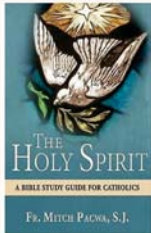

HEALTHY IMMUNE SYSTEM

When today's Feast of Corpus Christi was mandated for the whole church in 1264, the faithful rarely received communion. The bread transformed into a real presence of the divine Jesus was worshipped at the moment of consecration and elevation of the host, and in other devotions that we continue to observe. But Jesus' words, "*I am the living bread ... whoever eats this bread will live forever...*" (Jn 6:51) require more from the faithful than a final taste for the dying as people once thought. Jesus says that he represents that "bread from heaven" that sustained the Israelites during their forty years of desert wandering (Jn 6:51-58).

Just as their ancestors repeatedly complained to Moses in Exodus, so this crowd rejects Jesus' words that link his sacrificial death to bread and wine. Taking Jesus' words literally suggests cannibalism. But the meal is not ordinary food. Instead as St. Paul insists receiving the "body of Christ" has a rich set of meanings: belonging to the church community, sharing one Spirit received in baptism, and being transformed into the likeness of Christ. In a sermon to the newly baptized, St. Augustine tells them, "*You reply 'Amen' to what you are, and by replying you consent ... Be what you see and receive what you are,*" (Sermon 272).

Receiving the eucharist is not like a one-shot vaccine certificate needed to enter heaven. It might be like supplements advertised to boost the immune system. Every Christian has an active role in building up the body of Christ (1 Cor 12:12-26). We share the sufferings and joys of each part of that body so saying 'Amen' to what you are isn't just individual. Belonging to the body of Christ is a team activity. And there are no lonely bench warmers. As in a living body, every person's special role is necessary for a healthy church. But "healthy" does not require a super-model body. Remember God agreed to accompany a "stiff-necked people" whose faithfulness and love expressed in Christ's death.

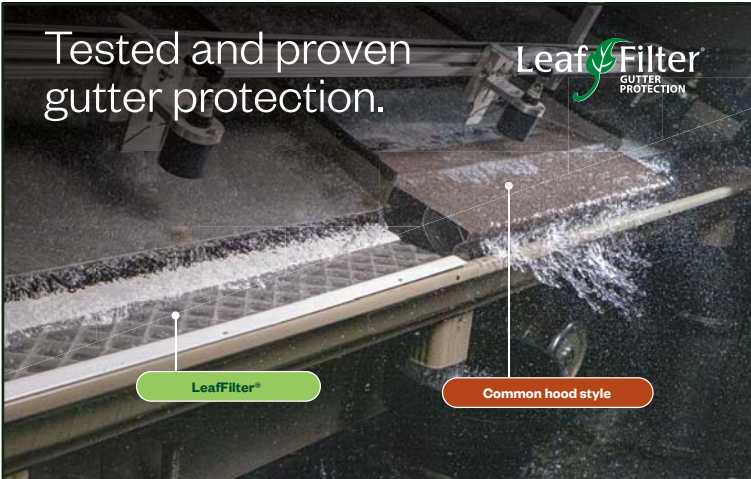

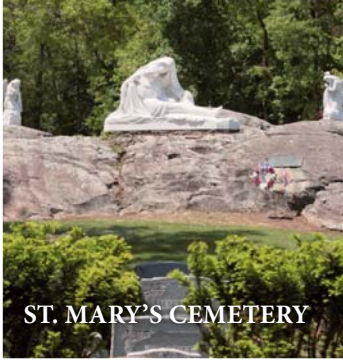
