The Honored Ambassador Before God (Part VII) . . .

One of the nifty things about being Catholic is that we never have a shortage of prayers available to us. When we're sitting in the back seat of an Uber, waiting in line at the store, or when we simply need a mental break from work . . . there's always a quick prayer we can offer up to God. The "Our Father" or the "Hail Mary" are always ready to hand, of course. But we also have the Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel, which Pope Leo XIII gave us for when we're experiencing temptation or faced with any threat of evil:

*St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle.
Be our protection against the wickedness and
snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray;
and do thou, O prince of the heavenly host,
by the power of God, thrust into Hell Satan and all the evil
spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls.*

The Angelus is a beautiful prayer about the mystery of the Incarnation. At one time in history there was the tradition that the Angelus was prayed three times a day: once at 6:00 in the morning, once at twelve noon, and again at 6:00 in the evening. It sanctified the workday, reminding us that when God took flesh as a human being, He engaged in the ordinary activities of human existence, in all its mundaneness, and sanctified the rhythm of human life. It combines the "Hail Mary" with lines from the gospels:

*The angel of the Lord appeared unto Mary,
and she conceived of the Holy Spirit.
Hail, Mary, full of grace (etc. . . .)
"Behold the handmaid of the Lord, let it be done unto me
according to your word."
Hail Mary (etc. . . .)
And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us.
Hail Mary (etc. . . .)
Pray for us, O holy Mother of God,
that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.*

A favorite among Orthodox Christians is the Jesus Prayer. It's a quick aspiration that they say throughout the day:

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Orthodox monks would inhale the first half—breathing in Jesus the Son of God; and exhale the last part—expelling their sins.

The Serenity Prayer is a popular one, and has been a mainstay for those in Alcoholics Anonymous:

*God, grant me the serenity
to accept the things I cannot change;
courage to change the things I can;
and wisdom to know the difference.
Living one day at a time;
enjoying one moment at a time;
accepting hardships as the pathway to peace;
taking, as He did, this sinful world
as it is, not as I would have it;
trusting that He will make all things right
if I surrender to His Will;
that I may be reasonably happy in this life
and supremely happy with Him
forever in the next.*

A less familiar prayer, very close in substance to the Serenity Prayer, is the Collect for Peace, taken from the opening prayer of an ancient Mass:

*O God,
source of holy desires, right counsels, and just actions,
grant to Your servants
that peace which the world cannot give,
so that our hearts may be wholly devoted to Your service,
and all our days, freed from dread of our enemies,
may be passed in quietness under Your protection.*

Longer vocal prayers include litanies and chaplets, such as the litany to the Sacred Heart of Jesus or the Chaplet of St. Michael (different from Pope Leo XIII's prayer to St. Michael). The best known of this genre of course is the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, which easily can be found with a quick Google search—or you can tune in to Boston Catholic TV at 3:00 in the afternoon and join Bishop Reed praying the Chaplet.

Such vocal prayers are an excellent way to begin to expand one's repertoire of prayers, collecting a wider library of orations beyond the Lord's Prayer, the "Hail Mary," the "Glory Be . . ." and "Now I lay me down to sleep." If one takes the time to say these prayers slowly, really letting oneself listen to and hear the words of the prayer, allowing them to sink in, their richness and beauty can make a profound impression on the mind and heart. Reciting the same prayer with a different inflection each time, choosing different words to emphasize, can keep the rote text fresh for us while also illuminating a different contour of meaning to the prayer.

These are wonderful ways to start a more serious routine of prayer. Maybe choose one or two to begin the day with first thing in the morning. They can help as primers to discipline one's mind—so often cluttered and racing with the mayhem of life as it's lived today; and a relatively easy way to slow the mind down, concentrate one's thoughts, and begin the initial approach to God in a prayerful mindset. And they're also handy prayers to recite silently at various times throughout the day, reminding us of God's constant presence with us and His unfailing desire to give us rest in His love.

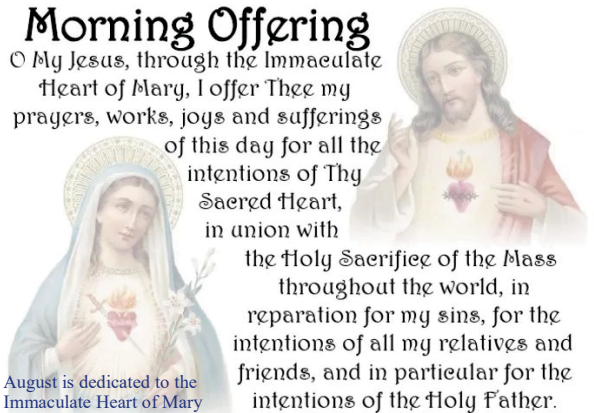
Morning Offering

**FOOD FOR LIFE**

Inhabitants of the 21st century world, in which wars and climate change have drastically limited food resources, eat such items as vegetable stew, protein cakes and acorn coffee while studying 20th century literature in Ian McEwan's dystopian novel, *What We Can Know*. A very different world from the mid-summer bounty in New England that even allows asking family to bring from their area fruits, veggies, cheeses, or breads that are especially delicious. Our first reading (Isa 55:1-3) summons people to God's banquet of rich food all free! The story of Jesus feeding a crowd of 5,000 men (+ women and children) with 5 loaves and 2 fish (Matt 14:13-21) is the only miracle story told in all four gospels.

The tough work of farming was part of the curse humans suffer for disobeying God's command in Gen 3:17-19. The invite in Isaiah might be God's promise of a heavenly banquet. Eternal life triumphs over death as St. Paul insists (Rom 8:35-39). Most early Christians read Isa 55 as the heavenly banquet with Jesus feeding 5,000 representing the Eucharist. Some scholars suggest this passage reflects a political vision of Jerusalem being restored as the city of God's light and justice for all people. Her voice summons listeners to join that project. Pope Leo XIV reflected on the work of rebuilding a devastated Jerusalem using Nehemiah 1-5 in *Magnifica Humanitas*.

The technology of modern war can distort its violence and devastation by focusing on statistics for effectiveness (sec. 198). Rather than let the "twelve baskets leftover" mute the call for human action in Jesus' story – statistics over people – we might ask how it imagines the common good. Jesus begins teaching and healing out of compassion for the crowd (Matt 14:14). Sending that many to purchase food in surrounding villages is unrealistic even if they had money. Disciples telling Jesus to do so is not God's compassion. The on-site option appears even more absurd. But Jesus persists. God's Kingdom is not constrained by the numbers. "Give us this day our daily bread", seeks life-sustaining food for all people.

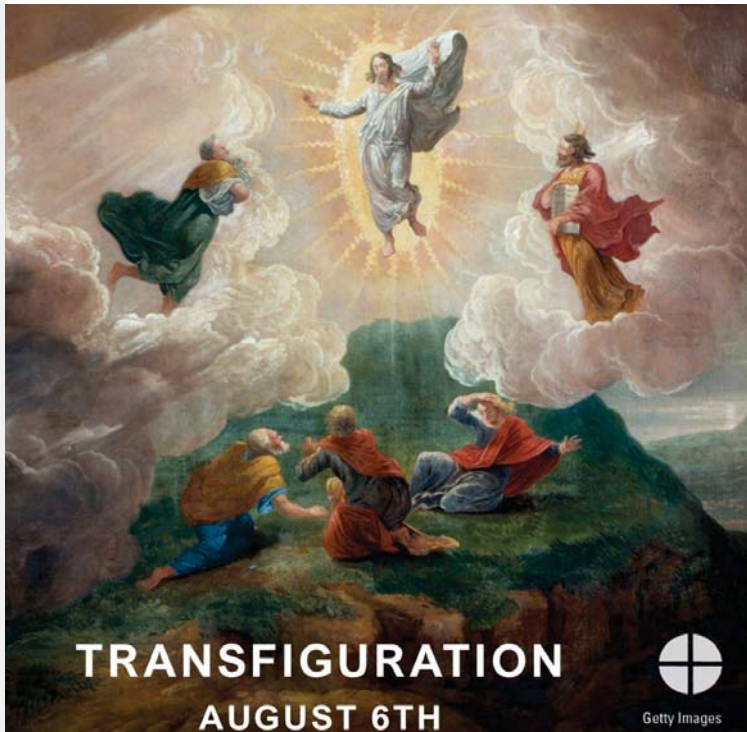

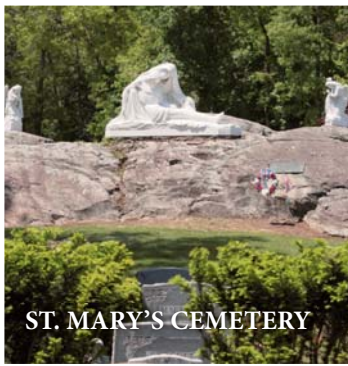
