The Honored Ambassador Before God (Part VIII) . . .

St. Padre Pio was renowned for being a startling mystic who could bi-locate (appear in two places at the same time), having the ability to read people's minds to a limited extent, and for suffering from stigmata (inexplicable punctures in his hands that mimicked Jesus's wounds from the crucifixion). However, he also had a reputation for being an irascible old coot. So one might justifiably be alarmed to have heard him exclaim—as he frequently did—“Bring me my weapon!” But the arsenal he had in mind wasn't your ordinary sort of armaments; he was talking about his Rosary beads. The battle he was fighting was spiritual warfare: the contest against the Devil and his league who so often assaulted the Franciscan saint (the downside of his amazing mystical experiences).

The Rosary is the most recognizable as a uniquely Catholic prayer. Tradition has it that it was given by Our Lady herself to St. Dominic de Guzman in a mystical vision as a tool to combat the heresy of Albigensianism. It fits verbal prayer tongue-and-groove with meditative prayer. For those who may be unfamiliar with the Rosary, it consists of five “decades” of “Hail Mary's” separated by an “Our Father”—a decade meaning ten recitations of the “Hail Mary.”

While it's perfectly fine to simply recite the vocal prayers, the Rosary actually is designed to facilitate meditation on the life of Jesus. There are four sets of “mysteries,” each set dedicated to a particular period in Jesus's life. For each set of mysteries, there are five events to meditate on:

The Joyful Mysteries (Jesus's infancy and childhood)

- The Angel Gabriel's Annunciation to Mary of the Incarnation
- Mary's visit to Elizabeth
- The Birth of the Christ Child
- The Presentation of the Infant Jesus at the Temple
- Mary and Joseph finding the adolescent Jesus at the Temple

The Luminous Mysteries (Jesus's ministry)

- John the Baptist's baptism of Jesus at the Jordan
- Jesus turns water into wine at the wedding at Cana
- Jesus's proclamation of the Kingdom of God
- The Transfiguration of Jesus on the mountain
- The institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper

The Sorrowful Mysteries (Jesus's Passion and death)

- Jesus's agony in the Garden of Gethsemane
- The scourging of Jesus at the pillar
- The crowing of Jesus with thorns
- Jesus carries His Cross
- The crucifixion and death of Jesus

The Glorious Mysteries (the Resurrection and post-Resurrection events)

- Jesus's Resurrection from the dead
- Jesus's Ascension into Heaven
- The descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles at Pentecost
- The Assumption of the Virgin Mary into Heaven
- The crowning of the Virgin Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth

Each set of mysteries has its given day of the week on which it's appropriate to pray:

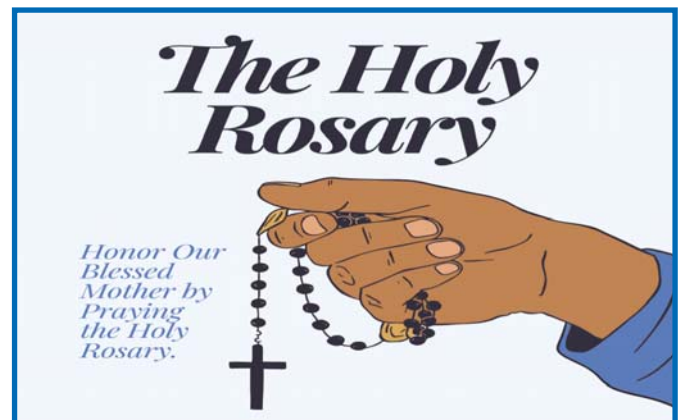
- The Joyful Mysteries on Mondays and Saturdays
- The Sorrowful Mysteries on Tuesdays and Fridays
- The Glorious Mysteries on Wednesdays and Sundays
- The Luminous Mysteries on Thursdays

It takes a little while to catch on to the Rosary, so give yourself some time to figure it out. There are other prayers that book-end the recital of the Mysteries, sort of like a prologue and an epilogue. If it's easier, you can hold off on these until you feel more comfortable with the pattern of the Rosary. The important thing is to enter into prayer.

The Rosary takes between fifteen and twenty minutes to pray, if you do all five mysteries. But it's OK if you only choose to do one decade. Once you've gotten the hang of it, the Rosary is a beautiful and poignant way of making the gospel more vividly real. When you spend a solid minute meditating on a particular episode, it's amazing how that event comes alive in the imagination and the details that occur to you that might escape notice if just reading about that moment in the Bible. I often find myself crying when praying the Rosary—especially when I'm praying the Sorrowful Mysteries.

The Rosary is an excellent introduction to Christian meditation. It provides ready-made material to focus one's mind on, so that the central moments of Salvation History become more dynamic and more personal for us. There also are aids that one can find online to help facilitate meditation when praying the Rosary. If the Gospel seems too remote to understand, or too threadbare to really get a feel for, then praying the Rosary is a great way to deepen one's appreciation for our Lord's life and sacrifice.

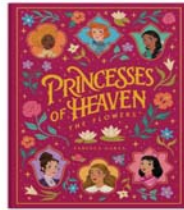
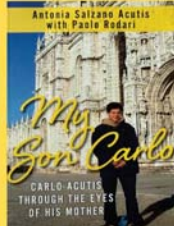
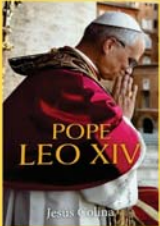

SURVIVAL TRAINING

The first episode of a PBS series, “Once Upon a Time in Space,” highlighted the women who belonged to that first group of civilian astronauts chosen by NASA. “I could have gone out on stage naked and no one would have noticed. They were so focused on the women,” one of the guys remarked. Once on board, survival training is the same for everyone. Female astronauts may have found it tougher to haul themselves up over the edge of a life raft bobbing around in the ocean, but some men had trouble with it too. Apply that image to Peter in today’s gospel (Matt 14:22-33).

Near the end of the series, one of the test-pilot astronauts who had trained with the group admitted to arrogant disdain for the civilians. He had never wanted to be paired with one of them. Looking back, he acknowledged that they were all brilliant people. Does Peter have some of that superiority complex when he shouts over the storm, “...if it’s you, command me to come to you on the water”? Given the order, “Come”, Peter has no choice but to step out there. All goes well as long as Peter keeps his focus on Jesus, but as soon as he starts to sense the raging seas panic sets in. He cries out, “Lord, save me”. Jesus grabs him out of the waves with a rebuke for not trusting the training drill.

Back in the boat with the storm over, the disciples worship Jesus as Son of God. Not a frightening ghostly apparition in the heart of the storm, but a God who rescues those sinking in deep waters (Ps 69:1-3). One drill does not complete survival training. This episode is the first Peter of several exchanges between Jesus and Peter. If Peter is to become the “rock” on which Jesus’ church is built (Matt 16:17-20), more survival training will be required. He consistently overestimates his own strength and resists Jesus’ journey toward death on the cross (Matt 16:21-28). Growing faith takes time and work.

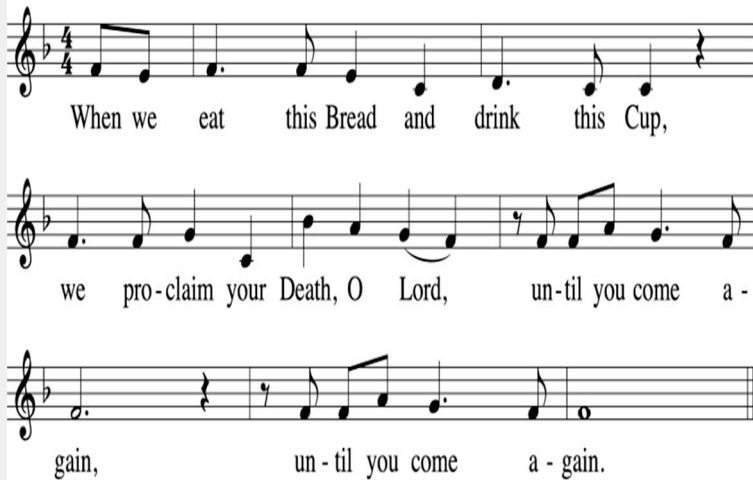

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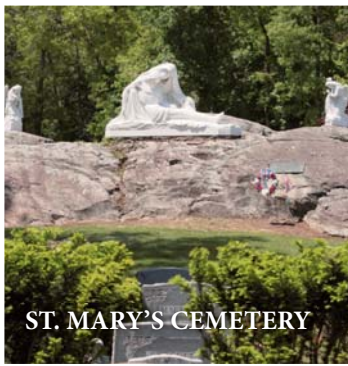
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ST. MARY'S CEMETERY
