The Honored Ambassador Before God (Part XII) . . .

My brother once revealed to our mother that he liked the Psalms because they were consoling, but that he stayed away from the Book of Proverbs because they convicted his conscience too badly. Setting aside for the moment the fact that this is a perilous way to approach Scripture, deliberating avoiding the parts that challenge oneself to ongoing conversion; but that aside, there also is a fair amount of Psalms that are something less than comforting.

Pope Benedict XVI has called the Book of Psalms the book of prayer par excellence. They are a collection of poems—or to be more accurate: song lyrics—in the Old Testament; and are among the richest veins of the Bible to pray with. “This Book expresses the entire human experience with its multiple facets and the whole range of sentiments that accompany human existence,” the late pope explains; “In the Psalms are expressed and interwoven with joy and suffering, the longing for God and the perception of our own unworthiness, happiness and the feeling of abandonment, trust in God and sorrowful loneliness, fullness of life and fear of death. The whole reality of the believer converges in these prayers.”

It’s precisely the raw humanity expressed in them that makes these poems so powerful. The particular conditions of the Israelite people in the various stages of their history are captured in the lyrics. We’re swept into their joy over the glory of the temple and Mount Zion or a majestic parade of victory. We’re drawn into their distress when they see that same temple profaned by an invading conqueror, or their depression at being driven into exile from their home. Their sorrow for sins committed, their elation at experiencing God’s pardon, their exhaustion with waiting for God to act in vindication of them, their struggle to maintain hope in God in the face of catastrophe, their awe at the wonder of God’s creation, their urgent pleading to God for help or salvation, their confidence in God’s providence, their recognition of their frailty when pursued by an enemy or maliciously lied about . . . all of this is shared with us when we enter into the Psalms.

The brilliance of these lyrics is that one need not know the original context in which they were written to experience their resonance. The theme of each psalm is universal enough that anybody, in any cultural moment, can recognize him/herself in the song. It takes only a little imagination to apply the verses to one’s

own particular life-circumstances, whatever they may be. One can easily see oneself saying these same words to God—or hearing in them an eloquence and honesty that perfectly expresses one’s own feelings when the right words failed us. Yes! that’s exactly right! we might find ourselves thinking; I wish I could’ve put it that way! We might even discover in the psalm a depth in ourselves that we never saw before.

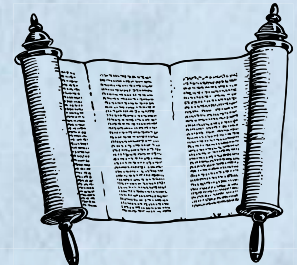
The Church also recognizes the voice of Christ in the Psalms—most particularly as He references them from the Cross: “I thirst,” echoes Psalm 42 (“Athirst is my soul for the living God”); “My God, my God, why have You forsaken me?” is the opening cry of Psalm 22; and “Into Your Hands I commend my spirit” is a direct quotation from Psalm 31.

But it’s not only those moments when Jesus expressly quotes the psalms that we hear His voice. The Church Fathers from Christianity’s earliest days identified certain psalms as being expressions of Jesus’s inner life, capturing those thoughts and feelings that are left undescribed in the gospels. St. Jerome, for instance, applied the 56th psalm to Jesus’s Passion; and St. Augustine found the same in Psalm 57. When we extend our imagination to think of Jesus’s suffering as we pray these psalms of lament, we can develop a richer appreciation for our faith and a deeper gratitude to our Lord for his sacrifice for us.

In the Psalms, the Word of God and the words of mankind converge. God’s words come down to us, and the script of our human condition rises to Him. The Catechism says of the Psalms that this “prayer is inseparably personal and communal; it concerns both those who are praying and all men. [...] Prayed by Christ and fulfilled in Him, the Psalms remain essential to the prayer of the Church.”

All this being true, the Psalms are an excellent starting point for the practice of *Lectio Divina*. Most of them are short, and even the longer psalms are divided into more bite-size units. But what they lack in length they more than make up for in depth. As such, praying with the Psalms is a beautiful way to begin to assimilate the Word of God into your own inner-life, letting the sacred Word become an expression of your own personal word.

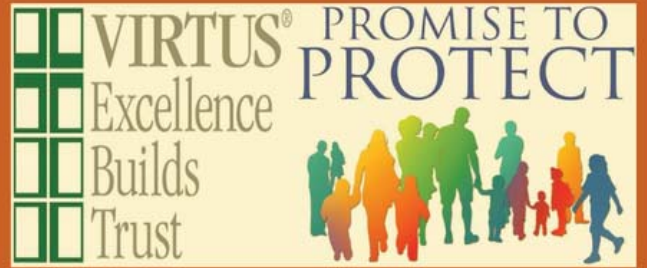
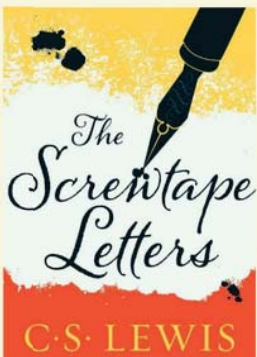

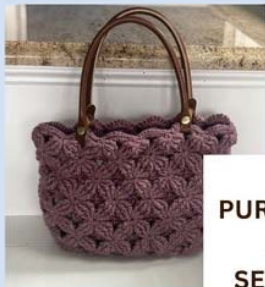

WILD WEST

School starting has dropped many youngsters into new social environments where they are sorting out rules of the road, figuring out a stranger’s behavior, and hopefully settling into a supporting group of friends. The six-year-old already has very definite views about good/bad actors ... a bit tricky since her mom works at the same school! Imagining today’s Scripture readings addressed to the dilemma of figuring out the wild west of first grade opens up new perspectives. Ezekiel needs to know when to issue a warning, aka. get the teacher (Ezek 33:7-9). For a child brought up with variants of the “love your neighbor,” and “do no harm to people or animals” (Rom 13:8-10), responding to aggressions suffered is a problem that does need discussion (Matt 18:15-20).

Ezekiel’s prophecies about the devastation by Babylonian armies that destroyed God’s temple and drove the Jewish elite, including the prophet, into exile had come true (ca. 587 BCE). So, some people might have concluded that God’s anger signaled an end to His covenant love for Israel. And, the prophet, himself, may have felt like checking out with the “I told you so” of a first-grader. Instead, the prophet who had done his duty as God’s warning siren, will remain on duty for a repentance and promises of future salvation/restoration. Talking a child out of that pleasure in deserved punishment takes some effort.

Our gospel has Jesus providing rules for grown-up Christians belonging to the several “house churches” in the city of Rome. Some, like Paul, who were Jewish might recognize in the first step, work it out privately an echo of Lev 19:17, “...you shall not have hate in your heart...reprove your neighbor,” and of Deut 19:15b, “...only on the evidence of two or three witnesses shall a charge be sustained.” Of course, for kids, dragging friends into the dispute isn’t desired, unless perhaps an older sibling helps. But the “did you ask why they said/did that?” is often our response. Our worst-case conclusion, “keep away...” is also Matthew’s (v. 17).

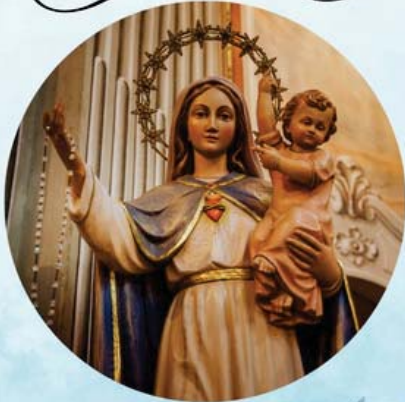

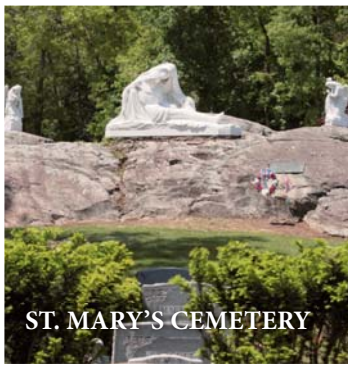
