Since 2017, the Art4Impact program invites children and adolescents to engage in a concrete and creative project: bringing joy and hope to hospitals through their drawings.

How it works

- 1. Imagine a positive emotion that you want to share
- 2. Select bright, vivid colours to illustrate this emotion
- **3.** Create a joyful universe or scene and tell your story in pictures
- Make sure the drawing is unique, personal and lively (avoid existing characters)
- **Display your drawing onto a hospital wall using our**Anouk4Impact app

Celebrate the creativity of young people and start to give them a voice to improve the world.








For children
