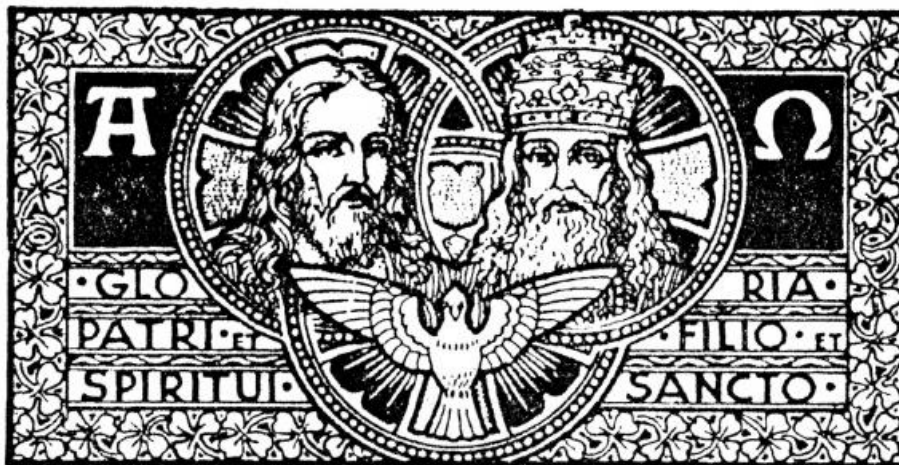

Received \$2160.78; To Goal \$7430.00

St. Joseph's will again host the **community blood drive on Friday, June 16** from 11:30 AM to 5:30 PM. We are again asking for workers to assist. We will need 3 persons to help with check ins, one other to help in the kitchen, and maybe 2 to bring bars and cookies and 2 to bring buns. And of course we are looking for as many as are able to donate blood as the supply continues to be low.

**Montini Hall Front project:** In September 2022 St. Joseph's Church, Rushford Finance council initiated the rebuilding of Montini Hall front due to deteriorating situation of the old structure. Most of the work was done in winter and only the landscaping and railing work is being taken up now. In the last two years this work urgently needed to be done. Thanks to a donor who gave \$45,000 for this work to be done. Our initial estimate for concrete work of the steps and ramp was \$25,000 but other things like Tarp and heat for winter, Replace of Gas line, landscaping, railing came up later. Therefore, the project estimates rose to a cost of \$70,133. An amount of \$25,133 is being utilized from the church fund. The Bishop's Board has approved the project. **Free will donations in memory of loved ones are welcome and appreciated.** Thanks to all who have given their time, treasure and talent to keep our church facilities in good shape.

**St. Joseph CCW** will again be holding a pie and ice cream social before and during the parade for Rushford Days. We are seeking donations of Pies and also a few workers, to help out in the kitchen.

**Holy Trinity Office Space:** As the Rectory which holds the current parish office is in the process of sale, the Finance Council felt the need of having a separate office space. So they came up with a suggestion of converting the current storage room at the HTCC into an office and conference room. The Bishop's board has given proxy to execute the project at a cost of \$28,149.23. We will use \$14,074.61 from the donation of an alumni and the balance \$14,074.61 from the donations of the parishioners to church fund. **Donations in memory of loved ones are welcome for this parish project.** In the month of July, we should be holding the parish office and meetings in the new space. Special thanks to Mark Schmit who is following up the project.

## **St. Rose News and Notes**

**St. Rose of Lima CMA 23 Project:** Water that is coming into the hall basement furnace room needs to be fixed. Water is coming in right by the electrical panels for the hall. This is an extremely dangerous situation. The solution proposed is land scaping by the hall and re-slope the cement by 2 furnace room windows. St. Rose of Lima Parish will use this year's CMA funds to help pay for fixing the water seepage. Initial estimate is approximately \$25,000. 100% of the amount over the goal will be returned to the parish for this project.

Can you remember a time when you heard a cappella choir sing in perfect harmony? Perhaps you have sung in a choir like that.
