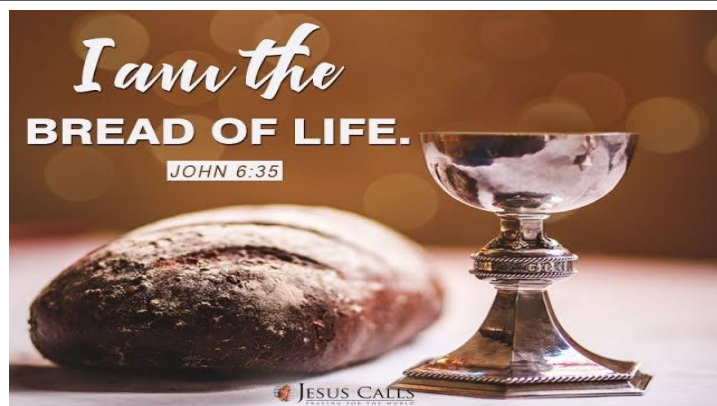

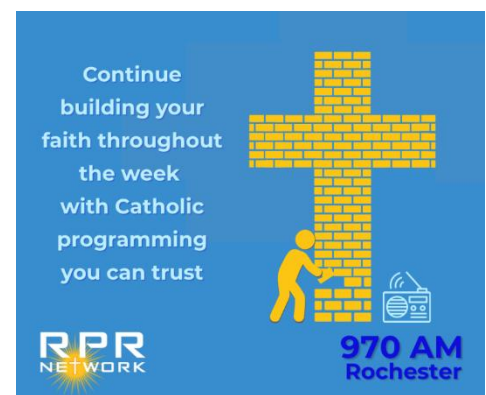

From the Pastor

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This past week, August 6th, the Church celebrated the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord where Jesus took Peter, James and John up a high mountain in Israel. It was here that he was 'transfigured before them' and 'His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light.' In praying the Rosary there is a fruit or grace for every mystery of faith that we meditate upon. The Transfiguration is the 4th Luminous mystery of the Rosary, and the fruit/grace of our meditation is a desire for holiness.

In the Incarnation he took on flesh and hid his divine nature. In the transfiguration of Jesus, we get a glimpse of this hidden nature of his, what he truly is underneath the cloak of his human flesh. Peter, James and John bear witness that he is fully human, but they also in this encounter witness his divine nature. He is God from God, Light from Light, True God from True God.

But what is His by nature, is to be ours by grace. We see in the Transfiguration of Jesus our own future glory that we are to share if we but listen to the voice of God the Father's Beloved Son. Through the merits of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection we too will be transfigured in glory. As we pray and meditate upon the mystery of Christ's transfiguration, we ought to be drawn to a deeper desire for holiness ourselves, as this transformation to glory begins and grows even now through our obedience to Christ.

We have Vacation Bible School this week at St. Rose of Lima. I am looking forward to meeting many of our young kids and witnessing their joy-filled and excited faith. Thank you to Ashley and Kelly who have been helping to organize this event and for the many other volunteers who have been assisting them in a variety of ways. Please note the couple of Mass time changes in Lewiston for this week and please join us and your kids for Mass.
