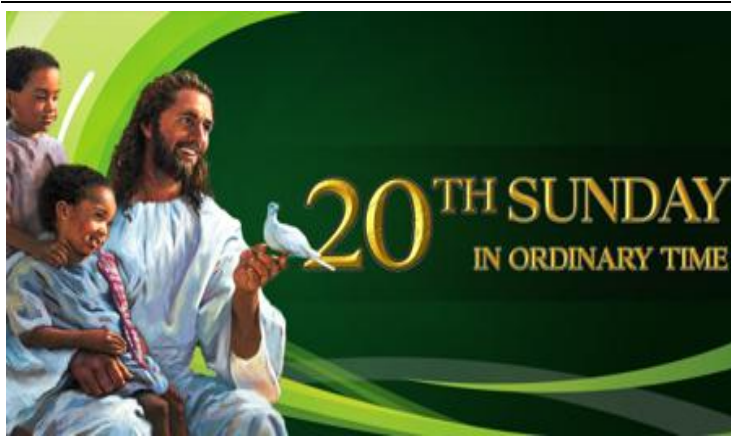

From our Pastor:

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It has been a joy to meet many of our young children at Vacation Bible School this week in Lewiston. Thank you again for the many parishioners, parents, grandparents, and high school students who helped out in a variety of ways to make the week go smoothly and for your witness to the Catholic faith you share with our young kids.

On Saturday August 15th we celebrated the Solemnity of the Immaculate Virgin Mary into Heaven. Typically it is a Holy day of obligation, but due to the fact it fell on Saturday this year, the obligation was lifted. There are four Marian dogmas, or definitive teachings, about Mary: That she is the Mother of God, that she is perpetually virgin, that she was immaculately conceived, and what we celebrated on Saturday, that she was Assumed into heaven. We as Catholics believe in and hold to these truths with 'divine and catholic faith'. Essentially, since the Church has formally defined these teachings, we can have absolute confidence that the Holy Spirit who is leading the Church, leads us into the fullness of truth and will not let the Church fall into error.

The Assumption of Mary was officially defined by the Catholic Church in 1950, but was a strongly held belief for much of the Church's history. Pope Pius XII declared, "The Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states, 'The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians.' In the Assumption of Mary, we rejoice in Christ's victory over the grave that Mary already fully participates in, and in which we place our confident hope that we too will share in this glory one day. May we call upon Mary's intercession often that she may lead us to her Son.

Know of my prayers for you. Please pray for me.
