Greeting from Father Chinnappa: from Mysore, India. Hope all is well with all families, It's a long time since I moved back to India from Lewiston tri-parish cluster. It took me month to get acclimatized to the climate, systems and traffic. I could meet my Bishop, priests, family and friends. They are happy to see me back home. There is great hospitality at my visits. It's getting to be two week since I came to my work place. This place is called Mysore in South India. It's monsoon time and people waiting for rain. Any way it is not too hot. I am in a seminary where students reside and are formed for priestly life. They are

known as Marian Fathers of the immaculate conception. You may view their web at Marian.org. They go to the nearby institute for theology classes which go on for four years. My role is spiritual animation, celebrating liturgies, directing. They are young and I am the oldest. They do many works and I don't need to cook, clean, or drive. Hope all is well with your family. I remember the many affections, farewells, gifts showered on me. You are all in my heart. I miss the beauty of Lewiston, the gentle people, who organize many activities all throughout the year for the benefit of the people. You are welcome to this place. It is a historical city with some tourist attractions. People are awaiting for rains as it is dry and the fields need water. We are praying.

From our Pastor:

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Very often in the season of Ordinary Time, instead of just using the Mass setting for the day and if there is no Saint of the day, I enjoy offering votive Masses. These Mass settings have more specific prayers for particular devotions like Votive Masses to the Holy Trinity, the Holy Spirit, St. Joseph, and the Holy Eucharist, amongst others. In particular, I enjoy offering a Votive Mass of the Holy Eucharist on Thursdays recalling the Last Supper/Holy Thursday, a Votive Mass of the Sacred Heart on Fridays, and Votive Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Saturday.

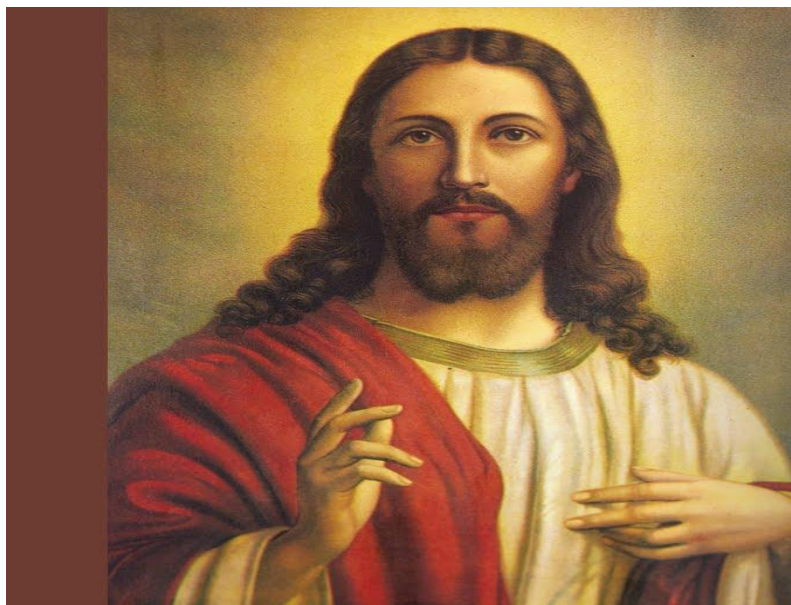
The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday and the Blessed Virgin Mary on Saturday are long running Catholic devotions, and in a more specific way, First Fridays and First Saturdays (of every month). A way of participating in these devotions is by attending Masses on those days, receiving Holy Communion, and going to Reconciliation within 20 days on either end of the Mass. I encourage you to look up some of the specific requirements for these devotions if you wish to participate.

With this in mind, in order to honor the Blessed Virgin Mother and to allow parishioners to participate in this devotion, I am planning to start a First Saturday Mass and an additional time for Reconciliation. Beginning the first Saturday in September, I will offer Reconciliation at 8:30 am followed by Mass at 9:30 am. This schedule of Reconciliation and Mass will rotate between the three parishes. September 5th will be in Rollingstone, October 3rd will be in Lewiston and November 7th will be in Rushford. They will then continue on a rotating basis for the First Saturday of every month.

This upcoming week, I am planning on taking a couple of days away with some friends. I am going to leave Thursday and come back on Saturday in time for all of the weekend Masses. With that, please note there will not be daily Confessions and Mass in Rushford on August 28th.

Know of my prayers for you. Please pray for me.
