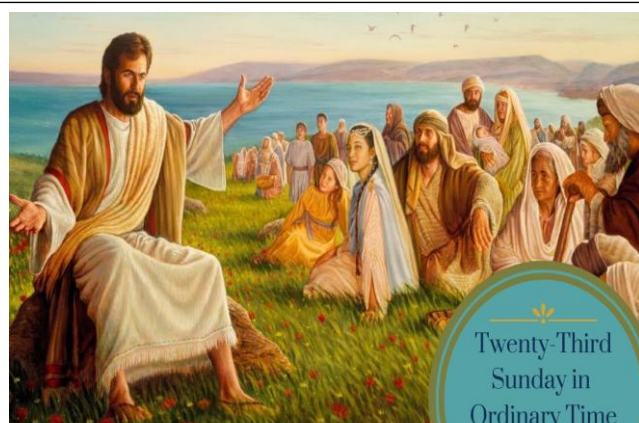

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Time continues to move right along, I have been here approximately two months already. Summer and summer activities are wrapping up as a new school year commences and fall sports and activities are underway. I unfortunately missed the Friday night football game in Lewiston against Southland, my high school alma mater.

I think I have gotten at least a brief chance to meet and greet everyone on Sundays. Something that has been on my mind however are the numerous parishioners who are homebound whom I have not yet visited. I have heard on a couple of different occasions from people that they were homebound but not receiving communion. I want to encourage if you know anyone - friend, neighbor, family member, who is not on our homebound list to call the office and make sure we have someone who can bring them the Blessed Sacrament once a week.

In addition to that, some of our homebound simply may be unable to drive themselves, but are otherwise capable of coming to Mass. If anyone has the capability to pick up and drop off, and if there are some of our homebound who would be interested in doing that, I think that would be a beautiful service of charity to our communities.

I will also in the coming months try to make home visits to our homebound parishioners in our communities to bring them the Sacraments and so I can have a chance to visit with them and get to know them. If you are someone who brings communion to our homebound, it might be worthwhile to send me an email of who you visit and when. I was given a list of our homebound, but I am not entirely sure how accurate it is. Lastly, if you know of anyone who is in need of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please let me know.
