I am grateful for Bishop Barron coming this weekend to offer Mass at Holy Trinity and to officially install me as Pastor. I know I have shared numerous times already, but I am very grateful to begin this assignment and for the Bishop's trust in me to lead and shepherd all of you in these three parishes.

Thank you to all at Holy Trinity who helped and organized in various capacities for the Church Festival last weekend; from the initial comments I have heard from people it was another successful event. Thank you also to all of those who have helped and organized for my Pastor Installation this weekend.

Please note that I will be absent from the parishes from the afternoon of September 23rd through October 2nd.
