

Dear Parishioners,

Every third Sunday of Lent, in all three years of the liturgical cycle, we will come to Jacob's well to witness the conversion of the Samaritan woman. The Church thinks that this Gospel passage is so important that we read it every year, without fail, during Lent. Perhaps we can explain why this is as we gather around Jacob's well. Why is this scene so important? In the story of the Samaritan woman at the well, we see God himself asking a human for a drink. And this woman is an outcast, a pariah.

Later on, Jesus will again ask for a drink. He did this on the cross. On Good Friday, he will say: "I thirst". In essence, we must understand that John is telling us that God wants us. God chooses us. God loves us. It is powerful to know that God thirsts for our love. No matter our sin, no matter our inconsistencies, no matter our feebleness. There is a depth of love for us that fills the heart of God. Every Lent, we truly need to hear that: as a thirsty man yearns for water, so God yearns for us; as a thirsty man seeks after water, so God seeks after us; as a thirsty man thinks only of water, so God thinks of us. A question may be asked here, as we often don't think of God as needing anything. How could he need our love in any real way?

Regardless of how we define God's nature in the abstract as impassable and unchangeable, we must see that Christ, the one who needs nothing, has voluntarily made himself needy, but only in order to communicate to us the life that is his. The past sins of our lives, and perhaps even the current ones now, make us feel that God doesn't really love us. Perhaps he loves us in a generic sort of way. Perhaps he loves us because he is God, but he doesn't like us. The truth of the matter is that God loves us, but he is also in love with us. This was the discovery of the Samaritan woman. She never knew how much she was loved and was searching for love in all the wrong places. As she sets aside her water jug, symbolizing her old way of life, she begins a new life as a disciple of Jesus.

All because she finally understood God's love.





**SAINT FRANCES OF ROME  
(1384-1440) March 9**

Nature and human nature—plagues and wars—turned late medieval Rome into a living hell, particularly for the sick and poor. Frances, by birth and marriage well provided for, was a devoted wife and mother; but like Benedictine Oblates who, to this day, “pray and work” while living with their families and working in the world, she joined like-minded laywomen friends in ministering to society’s most vulnerable. Frances’ charity was not only “hands on” but “in home.” Her palace becoming a hospital after the plague claimed two of her three children. When her husband’s death ended their loving marriage of forty years, Frances joined other widowed Oblates in community. In an interesting link to the United States, our nation’s premier religious congregation for women of color, the Oblate Sisters of Providence, in 1833 established bonds of spiritual communion with these “Oblates of Saint Frances” in Rome. **Third Sunday of Lent  
One Small Step**



In today’s Gospel, we see the Samaritan woman coming to faith. The steps she takes are our steps, too. Though she needs Jesus’ help, he approaches her first. He invites us to make the journey of faith long before we start, by putting us into a faithful family, giving us a curious heart that seeks the truth, sending us a friend or spouse whose example draws us to the Lord. The next step is acknowledging our need and our sinfulness. Admitting our need for God, and especially for God’s forgiveness, opens us to God’s saving grace. Another step is drawing closer to God in prayer. Jesus tells the woman, and us, that the best worship is honest and from the Spirit. When we begin to share our faith with others, we take the step of living our faith. Like the woman who told her neighbors about Jesus, we find that the people we have touched begin to find the Lord on their own. Our catechumens are taking these steps now, thanks to those who have helped them experience Jesus’ invitation to faith.
