## **Fraser Memorial Presbyterian Church**

Fraser Memorial was founded in 1925 as a chapel of First Pres in Sumter. They met in a school before constructing a building in 1929 at the northwest corner of Manning Avenue and Maxwell Avenue. In 1951 they were organized as an independent congregation. The new church was completed in 1972, and a fellowship hall was added in 2007. The old church was demolished around 2014-2015, and the entire property (including that portion of Maxwell Avenue) was obliterated to construct the new Exxon at the corner of Manning & Pocalla.
