FEELING THE SUMMER HEAT? YOUR CAR'S BATTERY IS, TOO!

Summer highs rather than winter lows pose the greater threat to battery life. When most motorists think of dead batteries that cause starting failure, they think of severe winter weather, but summer heat is the real culprit. To get the most life out of your battery, start by following a few simple steps:

- Be sure the electrical system is charging at the correct rate. Overcharging can damage a battery as quickly as undercharging.
- If your battery is the type that needs to be topped off, check it regularly, especially in hot weather.
- Add distilled water when necessary.
- Always replace a battery with one that's rated at least as high as the one originally specified.
- Keep the top of the battery clean. Dirt becomes a conductor, which drains battery power.

And of course, when in doubt, it's always best to get your car's battery tested by your local auto care professional!
