- · 2 teaspoons baking powder · 1 cup sour cream · 1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar
- ·1egg 1 teaspoon baking soda · 1 cup raisins (optional) · 1 teaspoon salt · 4 cups all-purpose flour
- · 1 cup white sugar

INGREDIENTS

- 1. In a small bowl, blend the sour cream and baking soda, and set aside.
- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Lightly grease a large baking sheet
- 3. In a large bowl, mix the flour, sugar, baking powder, cream of tartar, and salt. Cut in the butter. Stir the sour
- cream mixture and egg into the flour mixture until just moistened. Mix in the raisins
- 4. Turn dough out onto a lightly floured surface, and knead briefly. Roll or pat dough into a 3/4-inch thick round.
- Cut into 12 wedges, and place them 2 inches apart on the prepared baking sheet.
- Bake 12 to 15 minutes in the preheated oven, until golden brown on the bottom.


