Home Health care includes skilled nursing associated with performing and teaching about injections, tube feedings, catheter changes, wound care, observation and assessment of your condition, and the management and evaluation of your overall treatment plan.

## How Do I Qualify

There are well-defined qualifying criteria that are used to determine if Home Health services are appropriate for you. These include your homebound status, your need for skilled nursing services and skilled therapy care under the supervision of a licensed professional when your care needs are intermittent, meaning care is needed for at least 30 - 60 days
