A MESSAGE FROM YOUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

We have a wonderful lineup of events all month long, from patriotic singalongs to cool treats on hot afternoons and fellowship gatherings. Whether you're able to join us for a special occasion or just for a warm hello, your presence is always a blessing.

MEET Marlon Webb A FATHER'S PRIDE & A SERVANT'S HEART

Born on June 9 in Madison County, Florida, Marlon Jefferson Webb grew up surrounded by the rhythms of farm life. As the son of Alton and Viola Cruce, he learned the value of hard work early on, spending afternoons after school helping his father tend to their land. With four siblings beside him, Mr. Webb's childhood was shaped by family bonds and the steady guidance of his parents—his father a dedicated farmer, his mother a caring homemaker.

After graduating from Madison County High School, Mr. Webb took his first steps into the working world as a patient orderly at Madison County Memorial Hospital. In 1968, he answered the call to serve his country and enlisted in the United States Army. His years in uniform took him far from home, including a period of service in Vietnam. When his military service ended in 1975, Mr. Webb carried home not just memories, but also the quiet pride of having met President Richard Nixon upon his return from Vietnam—a moment he recalls with honor.

Returning to civilian life, Mr. Webb built a new career in construction. Along the way, he found lasting happiness in marriage, sharing 32 years with his beloved spouse. The cou-

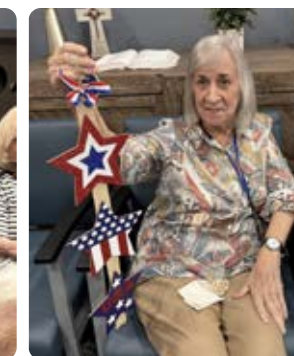
ple's greatest joy was the birth of their daughter, Della—a moment Mr. Webb still calls the most special of his life. To family and friends, he's always been "Shorty," a nickname that sticks and speaks to the warmth others feel in his presence.

He is a proud member of Hopewell Baptist Church, where his faith is the foundation of his days. 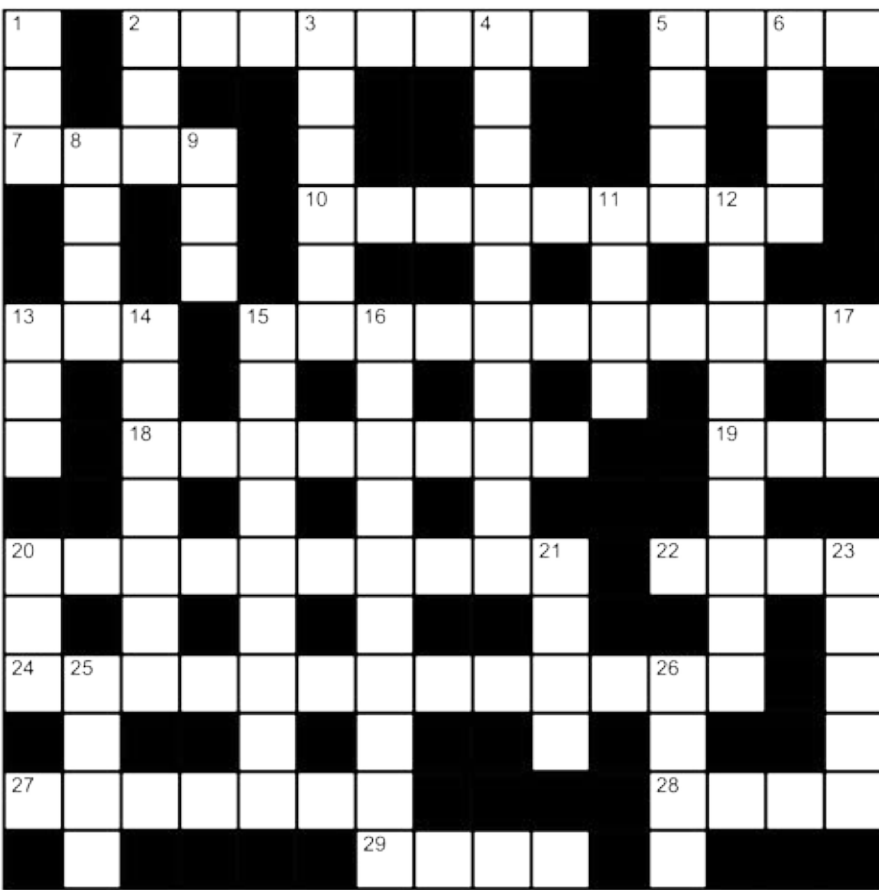
