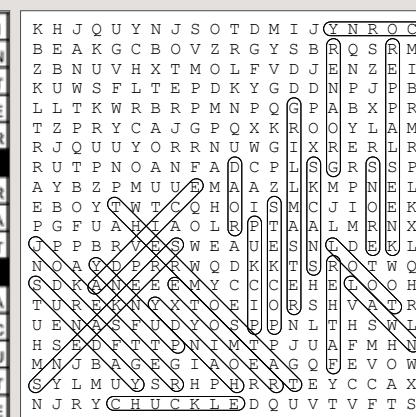

Join us in celebrating the beauty of summer, reaffirming our trust and gratitude for the countless ways God enriches our lives here at Legacy Village.

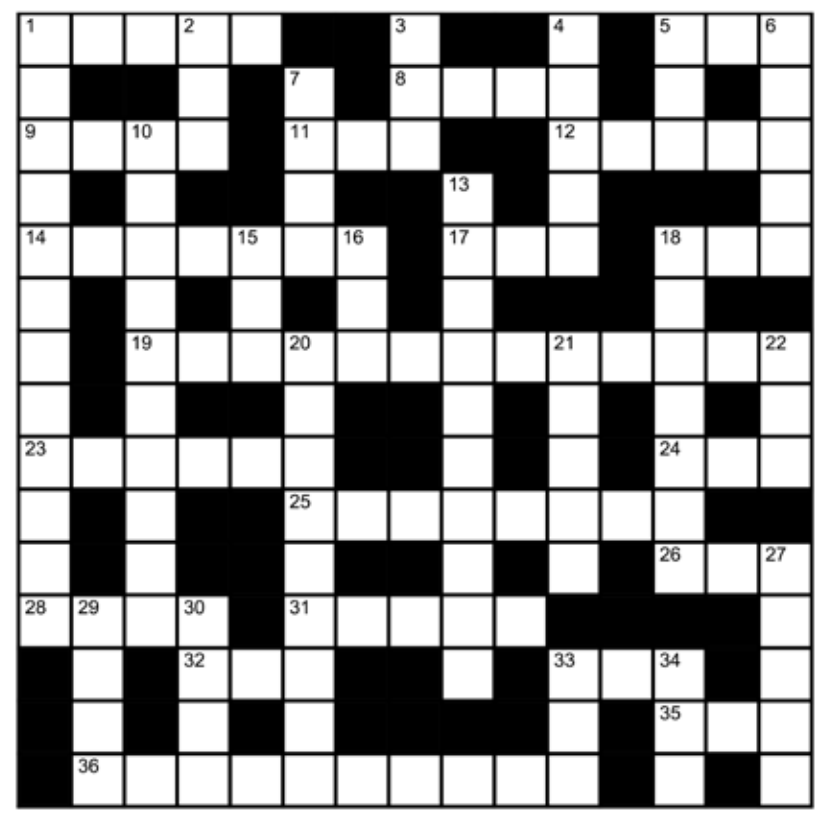
