What have we been up to...

Hedgehogs

In Hedgehogs, the babies have been exploring a variety of textures through messy play activities. They have also been learning about different colours and shapes while developing their curiosity about the world around them. The children especially enjoyed hunting for insects in the garden and exploring nature outdoors.

Butterflies

In Butterflies, the children have been learning to recognise their colours, shapes, and letters of the alphabet. They have been enjoying activities such as 'A is for apple' and 'F is for fish' helping to build early language and literacy skills. The children have also loved reading a variety of stories together, including interactive hide-and-seek stories.

Little Toads

Little Toads have shown a great interest in *Dinosaurs* recently and have enjoyed taking part in lots of Jurassic-themed activities. The children have also loved exploring water play, particularly with sea animals. Alongside this, we have been focusing on supporting the children to express their emotions and talk about how they are feeling.

Our New Summer Menu Coming Soon!



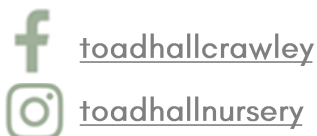
