# What we have been up to ...

This month, Little Toads and Owls have been little scientists, exploring exciting experiments and discoveries. They created a poppy field by mixing red and green dye with bicarbonate soda and vinegar, observing the fascinating reactions. We also experimented with oil and water, and even made "fireworks in a jar," which sparked curiosity and introduced new vocabulary such as FIZZ, BANG, and POP. Messy play has been just as popular, with the children exploring the texture of gloop. They loved getting hands-on and discovering descriptive words like runny, sticky, and smooth. Trains have also captured our children's imaginations this month. We learned about trains from around the world and explored the different places they travel, from bustling cities to mountain ranges, expanding both knowledge and curiosity about the wider world.

In Hedgehogs we have been concentrating on sensory play and learning how to be creative. The children have loved clapping in the foam to create indoor snow (lots of mess was made and giggles had). We have created lots of artwork like poppies for Remembrance Day using our hands in red paint and glitter, they also used different colours and round stampers to create a spotty piece in aid of Children in Need.

# Recipe of the Month - Parsnip. Butterbean & Apple Soup

(Serves 4-6)



## Ingredients

Parsnips - (peeled & diced) - 500g

Onion - (roughly diced) - 1 whole

Carrot - (roughly diced) - 2 whole

Garlic clove - (chopped) - 4 cloves

Butterbeans - 1 can

Apples (cored and chopped) - 2

whole

Veg Stock - 1 cube

Rosemary - 1 tsp

## Method

 In a large pan, sweat the onions and garlic until cooked (but with no colour in a bit of butter.

Add the carrots, potatoes and parsnips and apples.

3.Fill the pan with water to a level just above the vegetables.

4.Add butterbeans.

5.Bring back to the boil and then allow to simmer until all the ingredients are soft

6.Blend to a smooth consistency.

7 Serve with half a haguette
