In **Little toads** we have been creating activities that encourage problem solving like building more complex towers and towns with the small world toys, using tweezers to pick up different items and obstacle courses in the garden.

In **Owls**, the children expressed an interest in *Space*, we created a moon tuff tray where the children explored different textures and learnt the names of planets and constellations. We have also been reading books that explore the different parts of the rocket to make it zoom through the sky. We have also been enjoying our new ZEN garden and practising yoga out there in the sunshine!

Our New Summer Menu Coming Soon!



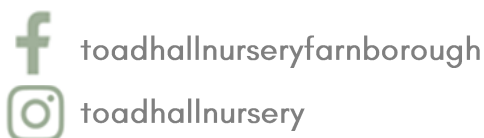
