Recipe of the Month - Parsnip. Butterbean & Apple Soup

(Serves 4-6)



Ingredients

Parsnips - (peeled & diced) - 500g Potatoes (chopped) - 3

Onion - (roughly diced) - 1 whole

Carlia alaura (abannad) A alaura

D. 41-1-1-1-1

Apples (cored and chopped) - 2

whole

Veg Stock - 1 cube

Rosemary - 1 tsc

Method

 I.In a large pan, sweat the onions and garlic until cooked (but with no colour) in a bit of butter.

Add the carrots, potatoes and parsnips and apples.

3. Fill the pan with water to a level just above the vegetables.

4.Add butterbeans.

5.Bring back to the boil and then allow to simmer until all the ingredients are soft.

6.Blend to a smooth consistency.

7. Serve with half a baguette.
