## What we have been up to...

**Hedgehogs** have enjoyed National Bee Day by planting some seeds to encourage the bee's and butterflies to explore their garden. Now the weather is warming up they have been exploring lots of water play activities including using their new animal boats.

**Butterflies** opened their own clinic to celebrate National Nurses Day, the children had a wonderful time dressing up as nurses and doctors, playing with all the equipment. They made their own bees in paint and created various prints to make flowers in honour of National Bee Day and the Chelsea Flower Show. Butterflies used their nature treasure they had collected from home to create a large print that is displayed in their room.

**Little Toads** have been learning all about our wonderful nurses for Nurses Day last month. They explored through role play with bandages and dressing up. They have also been exploring in cornflour for National Bee day. Talking about how important bees are to our environment.

**Owls** have been talking about school transitions, they have been exploring different school uniforms in the role play, talking about the different colours and about how school makes us feel. They have also been learning more about self-care, wiping their noses and putting on their own sunscreen. ## Our New Summer Menu Coming Soon!



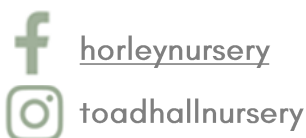
