## Children's clothing

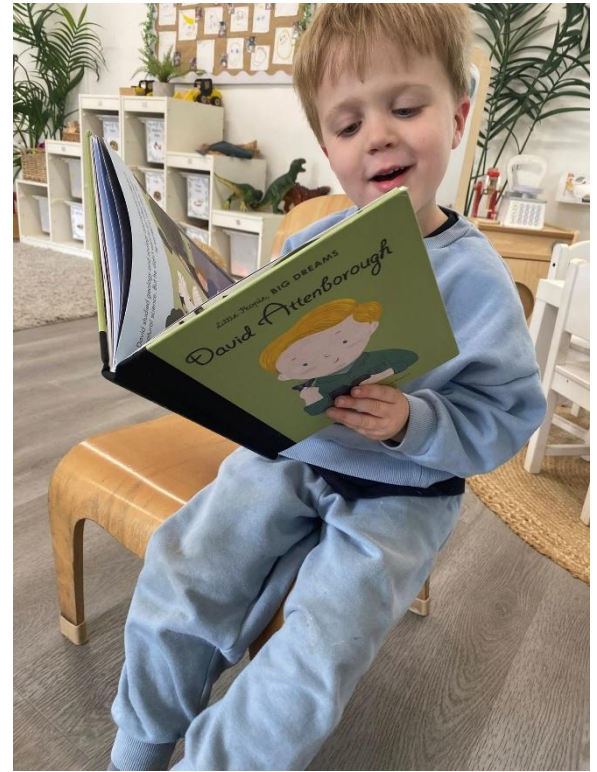
Reminder no open toe shoes/sandals or crocs please and please ensure that children have a name labelled coat for the garden.

## Our New Summer Menu Coming Soon!



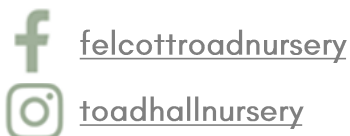
