We are starting to prepare our children for going to school focusing on developing their independence skills, putting on their own coats and shoes ready for this transition.

We are implementing a travel buddy for each room from next month, there will be a Hedgehog, Toad and Owl, that will come home with children for the weekend. This is to promote for the children to talk about what they have been doing with their families. We are very excited for this.

What we have been up to...

Owls have had a very exciting month, as many of you know we have had some caterpillars and the children have watched them grow into beautiful Butterflies, this has sparked so much interest in the children and been a much-loved topic of conversation among the Owls. Based on the children's interest in mark making we have implemented a writing table for the children, they have used one handed tools to make snips in the paper and hole punch. Next month we are looking forward to focusing on preparing our children who are going to school in their independence skills.

Little Toads have reintroduced their good morning train song this gives the children the opportunity to say hello to all of their friends whilst developing their communication and language skills. We have also engaged in more music and movement sessions for the children focusing on moving our whole body to the beat of music and developing our gross motor skills.

Hedgehogs have been busy exploring using all their senses engaging in the new mud area we have been introducing new language such as muddy, soft and squishy. We have also been using natural resources such as leaves, pinecones and twigs to mark make.

Our New Summer Menu Coming Soon!



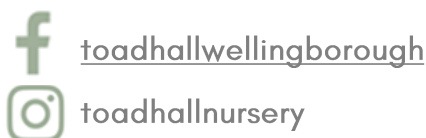
