Recipe of the Month - Beef and Butternut Stew with Mash

(Serves 5)



Ingredients

- · 850g braising steak, diced
- 1/2 butternut squash, peeled and diced
- 1 medium sweet potato, peeled and diced
- 1 medium parsnip, peeled and dised
- · 1 courgette, diced
- 1 large onion, peeled and chopped
- · 1 tbsp sunflower oil
- 2 heaped tablespoons plain flour
- 500ml water
- 2 tbsp tomato puree
- · 1 tsp thyme
- 400g potatoes

Method

- 1. Pre-heat the oven to 140 °C, 275°F or Gas 1.
- Heat the oil in a casserole dish, coat the meat with flour and brown in the hot oil.
 Remove the meat to a plate.
- 3. Fry the onions in the casserole and when they are soft add all the other vegetables.
- 4. Put the meat back into the casserole; add the water, tomato puree and herbs.
- 5. Cover with tight lid and cook in the oven for 2 ½ hours until the meat is tender.
- 6. Cook the potatoes in boiling water and mash with butter.
