## Our New Summer Menu Coming Soon!



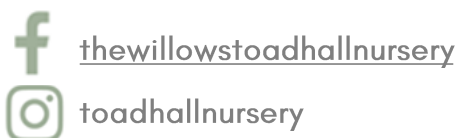
