THE RED BLAZER COMMITTEE 2022



- School fees must be up to date. The School of Leadership is not part of the formal educational offering of the school and is regarded as a “nice to have
- Nett Demerits must be below 30.
- Pupils must have a proven track record of participation (Participation points).
- Previous School of Leadership events must have been paid for. If a pupil owes money, he / she won't receive an invite to the next event.

School of Leadership Qualification Criteria



Grade 8 Desert Walk: Pupils nominated by registration teachers.
Grade 9 Desert Walk: Pupils nominated by Heads of Houses.
Grade 10 Desert Walk: Pupils voted on by their peers.
Grade 11 Desert Walk: Head Prefects and Red Blazer applicants who need a Desert Walk.
Grade 12 Desert Walk: Red Blazer applicants only.

All other events: Pupils apply. We check whether they qualify based on the criteria, and then invite successful applicants.

School of Leadership Selection criteria



- At Veldschool we hand out Red Blazer application forms
- In Nov/ Dec exam time, pupils make an appointment to see me.
- During our meeting, I book them on all the events they need to complete in their Grade 11 year in order to qualify for the RB.
- I provide them with a form that confirms their booking. The cost of each event AND the total cost of their Journey.
- The School of Leadership Calendar is available on the School's website and updated regularly.
