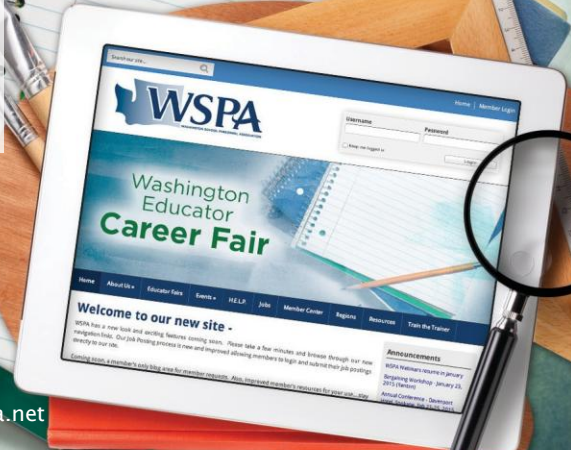

- All participating school districts, educational service districts, private schools and colleges will have booths staffed by personnel available to meet with candidates, and provide information and materials.
- Many districts have interview booths and staff ready to conduct interviews of prospective candidates.
- Our Fair offers candidates the opportunity to make contacts with personnel directors, principals and other school representatives.
- School personnel commonly use our Fair as an opportunity to share information about their organization and programs. They are asked to have postings of current and/or anticipated position vacancies at their booths.
- Candidates find our Fair particularly beneficial for learning about school districts and private schools, and also for obtaining application processes.
- The Washington State Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction Professional Education and Certification offices to assist with questions and concerns regarding certification.



Who will attend?

- School administrators looking for qualified candidates for classroom, educational staff associate, special education, administrative and certificated support staff assignments.
- Graduates, experienced teachers and administrators seeking the opportunity to meet with personnel and teachers to learn about anticipated vacancies and the application process.
- College and university personnel assisting their graduates in the job search process and providing information about post graduate study.
- Washington State certification officials may attend the fair and will be available to answer questions and provide assistance.
- Last year's Fairs attracted representatives from over 140 public school districts from eight states, private schools and was attended by approximately 1,050 candidates.
