



Timothy Van Stratton



**Village of Addison****Regular Board Meeting Minutes ~ November 10, 2025**

The Village of Addison held its Regular Monthly Board Meeting on Monday, November 10, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. at the Addison Community Center. Deputy Mayor Graham welcomed the community and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

IN ATTENDANCE: Deputy Mayor Bo Graham, Trustees Lorne Hults, Tara Watson, Dennis Rattay, and Village Clerk/Treasurer Donna Taylor. Department Representatives: Code Enforcement Officer Nick Lewis-Nolton. Mayor Ed Soporowski, Officer-In-Charge Ken Grover, DPW Working Foreman Charles Wright, and Fire Chief David Hatch were marked as absent.

SPECIAL GUEST SPEAKER: Bob Nichols provided a brief update on the 2026 Steuben County Budget. Key takeaways include that the county expects an increase of 1.8% to 1.9%, which remains below the 2% cap. The primary budgetary increases are due to wages and salaries necessary for maintaining adequate staffing levels, as well as costs for legal counsel.

MEETING MINUTES/DEPARTMENT REPORTS/BILLS: The Board approved meeting minutes for the October 21 regular monthly board meeting, monthly department reports, payment of bills, and payroll certification.

PUBLIC COMMENT #1: No public comment.

PERSONNEL: The Village Board approved for the Village Clerk to post for a full-time General Laborer position for the DPW Department, effective immediately.

NEW BUSINESS: The Board of Trustees approved the following agenda items during New Business: (1) Wade's Landing Community Service Project for Addison Senior Johnathan Spangenberg, (2) Resolution 4-2025: Designation of Village Elections, (3) Resolution 5-2025: Publication designating the office(s) to be filled and the term(s) thereof, (4) Resolution 6-2025: Designation of location for Village Election, (5) Resolution 7-2025: Acceptance of Absentee and Early Mail Ballot Applications, (6) Certification of 2025-26 Unpaid Village Taxes, (7) Retirement Reimbursement for Brad Fuerst, and (8) Sewer Fund Year-End Fund Balance Correction.

REVIEW/DISCUSSION – 1st READING OF POLICIES: The Board of Trustees received the following policies for review/discussion: Tobacco-Free Workplace Policy, Public Complaint & Grievance Procedure Policy, Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) Compliance Policy, and Donations, Sponsorships & Gifts Acceptable Policy.

PUBLIC COMMENT #2: Rondy Hand inquired about all of the old telephone poles located throughout the village that have wires hanging off them, which are causing traffic interference. Who is responsible, and when will they be removed?

ADJOURNMENT: The Board adjourned at 7:14 pm.




