





Joan Lee (Davis) Reppert, 90 A Lifetime of Family, Faith, and Music

Joan Lee (Davis) Reppert, age 90, of Ithaca, NY passed away peacefully on Tuesday, January 13, 2026 at Cayuga Medical Center in Ithaca.

Joan was born on December 28, 1935 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Elmira, NY. She was the daughter of the late John and Ruth Ann (Robinson) Davis. Joan married the late Rev. Nelson Roger Reppert on June 19, 1955 and they had three children together. She was a graduate of Addison High School, Class of 1953, where she participated in cheerleading and concert band.

Joan held a BS in Music Education from Mansfield University and an MA in Religious Studies from Mundelein College, and received graduate credit from Ithaca College.

Music, faith, and family were the guiding passions in Joan's life. She taught piano for three decades, and was certified as a Suzuki string instructor. Joan was a widely published composer and arranger, primarily of songs of worship. Early in her career she held teaching certifications in both New York and Pennsylvania, and served as a music teacher in the Corning-Painted Post School District. Throughout her life, Joan served as a sought-after piano accompanist for many vocal groups, including the Barnstormers Men's Chorus.

Joan held a variety of roles in the United Methodist Church, where her husband Nelson served as Minister.

Joan was on the musical staff of St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Ithaca, where she developed a 35 member folk choir, a 20 member children's choir, and a handbell choir program that included three separate groups. She also directed musical dramas for worship.

Throughout her career, Joan played piano and organ at numerous Methodist churches, including St. Paul's in Ithaca, University Methodist in Syracuse, Grace United Methodist in Corning, and Christ's United Methodist Church in Elmira. She also served at congregations in Tully and Pulaski, NY and Jacksonville, FL.

For many years Joan served as a communications officer for the Upper New York Conference of United Methodist Women (now United Women in Faith). She also held administrative and youth ministry roles with a number of United Methodist Churches at various times throughout her career.

In addition to her music and her faith, for Joan, family was the third leg of a life well-lived. She loved spending time with her children, grandchildren, great granddaughter, and an extended family of siblings, in-laws, nieces, and nephews. For decades, Joan and Nelson served as hosts and eager participants in summertime gatherings of family and friends at Keuka Lake—joyous occasions filled with competitive watersports, delicious food, gentle ribbing, and enjoyment of the natural beauty of the Finger Lakes. According to Joan's younger sister Linda Roth, the family cottage on Keuka was always her "happy place."

Joan was the eldest of four siblings. Joan's youngest brother Richard Davis, 12 years her junior, has fond memories of his sister being selected as the Addison Fire Department's Fireman's Queen, and getting to ride on the float in the Village parade. Alan Davis, meanwhile, recalls his sister singing "I'm Called Little Buttercup" as the lead in the Addison High School production of Gilbert and Sullivan's H.M.S. Pinafore.

"She had a great, great life," Alan recalls about his sister Joan. "She loved a lot of people, and everyone loved her."







Village of Addison

Regular Board Meeting Minutes ~ December 8, 2025

The Village of Addison held its Regular Monthly Board Meeting on Monday, December 8, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. at the Addison Community Center. Mayor Soporowski welcomed the community and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

IN ATTENDANCE: Mayor Ed Soporowski, Trustees Bo Graham, Lorne Hults, Tara Watson, and Village Clerk/Treasurer

Donna Taylor. **Department Representatives:** Code Enforcement Officer Nick Lewis-Nolton and Officer-In-Charge KenGrover. Trustee Dennis Rattay, DPW Working Foreman Charles Wright, and Fire Chief David Hatch were marked as absent.

MEETING MINUTES/DEPARTMENT REPORTS/BILLS: The Board approved meeting minutes for the November 10 regular monthly board meeting, monthly department reports, payment of bills, and payroll certification.

PUBLIC COMMENT #1: Sherry Jelliff expressed her gratitude to Mayor Soporowski for addressing the issue of bagged leaves that the DPW department had repeatedly overlooked. She also thanked Officer Stewart for his swift response to the accident that occurred Friday night in front of her house. Additionally, she raised a concern about the curve at Grove and Baldwin, describing it as a problematic traffic area that needs attention due to issues such as speeding and vehicles driving on the wrong side of the road. Kathy Riley questioned why the school district was responsible for plowing and maintaining Cleveland Drive during the recent snowstorm, emphasizing that the upkeep of village roads should be the responsibility of the DPW crew. She also inquired about the specific job duties of the DPW. Eva Sue Cunningham raised concerns about Trustee Rattay's lack of attendance at various village meetings. She also commented on the Christmas lights and decorations at 5-Corners Park, expressing disappointment that the village does not recognize the value these decorations have provided to the community for over 50 years. She suggested that the village consider establishing a special tree lighting fund to support the purchase of new lights and decorations. Gary Aumick commented on the pothole on the Grove/Baldwin and the fire hydrant in front of his house being fixed.

PERSONNEL: The Village Board approved the following personnel appointments: (1) Appointment of Connor Woodworth as a full-time DPW General Laborer serving a 6-month probationary period, and (2) Appointment of Volunteer Fire Department Members of Jennifer Figueroa, Cyrus Gilliam, and Brandon Lane.

OLD BUSINESS: The Board of Trustees approved the following agenda items during Old Business: (1) Village of Addison Policies ~ Tobacco-Free Workplace Policy, Public Complaint & Grievance Procedure Policy, Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) Compliance Policy, and Donations, Sponsorships & Gifts Acceptance Policy.

PUBLIC COMMENT #2: Rich Cilino inquired about the status of the Dissolution Study and Steering Committee. Sherry Jelliff asked if there could be anything done about parking on both sides of Steuben Street.

ADJOURNMENT: The Board adjourned at 7:47 pm.
