#### Addison's First Blood Drive of the 2025-2026 School Year

The Addison high school held a blood drive with American Red Cross on October 2, 2025. Students had to make an appointment by scanning a barcode on posters around the school either in the mornings or after school. Students 16 or older were eligible to donate with a permission slip signed by a parent or guardian; teachers donated as well. Students went to the auditorium during their scheduled time and were required to answer questions about their health and had their blood pressure and heartrate taken.

Many students were nervous as this was their first time donating blood, and the Red Cross workers were very kind and patient. After students and staff had their blood drawn, they sat at a table for fifteen minutes with other donors to enjoy snacks and drinks provided. The process was painless and quick; many people said they were happy they donated and will do it again next time the opportunity is given. The event was very successful; we had a record donation of 24 units. Each unit saves three lives; therefore, in total, the Addison staff and students saved 72 lives. This was the best turnout that Addison has had. Addison High School will hold three more blood drives throughout the school year: Jan 29th, March 26<sup>th</sup> and May 28<sup>th</sup>.

On October 8, 2025, 7<sup>th</sup> Grade students went to the Northrup Hill School House and Wildlife Sanctuary.






Welcome to Addison, Mr. Klawitter



#### Mrs. DuBois' Art Classes

Mrs. DuBois' Creative Crafts students began the year by exploring both simulated and actual texture. They were shown painting techniques, such as the dry brush technique for creating a rough simulated texture and applying pigment heavily for a rough actual texture. For their project, they drew lines with Elmer's glue on poster board. Once dry, they covered it with heavy-duty foil and rubbed their fingers over it to reveal



the glue's texture. They then used a scratchboard tool to create various patterns, which represented actual texture.

Finally, they adhered the foil to a black construction paper background and continued the designs with metallic markers, adding simulated texture.

Drawing & Painting students explored the concept of contour lines, which outline the outermost edges of forms and illustrate the dramatic shifts in planes within those forms. They discovered that a contour drawing is created when the artist focuses intently on the subject while allowing the pencil to flow freely. The objective of contour drawing is to produce a line that authentically represents what is observed, training the hand to mimic the eye's movements. Additionally, students practiced various types of contour line drawings, including Bline Contour, Continuous Line Contour, Modified Contour, and Cross-Contour. For their project, they created a Modified Contour drawing of hands in diverse positions



Valley students learned about the letter B. They made a letter B craft of a bumble bee and had to find the letter B. They did many letter B activities. Students read fall stories and continue to work on colors, shapes, and numbers. At Knights Know It, they talked about how important it is to always stay with grown-ups so that they stay safe! They also talked about how Deputy McCoy and K9 Tripp are heroes.

Some classrooms did a science experiment where they put vinegar in a water bottle, then put baking soda in a balloon. After that, they put the balloon on the bottle so the baking soda mixed in with the vinegar. They talked about how this causes a reaction. The reaction caused the balloons to inflate! They also talked about how bottle, balloon and baking soda all start with letter B. Miss Gunn brought in some baby bunnies to share with everyone. Mrs. Wright took a hayride in Mrs. Henry and Mrs. Gill's classroom.




