

Addison Area Christmas Food Baskets

The Christmas season is definitely here and many in our community will need support in the way of food, and perhaps even help securing toys and gifts for their children. While many of the food items, time and other expenses are donated, the perishable items are purchased. We also purchase most of the non-perishable items needed to complete each basket in order to be able to help all those who depend on this effort.




