

# Addison Area Christmas Food Baskets

Much of the non-perishable food items are donated through local food drives. Community members, churches, organizations, businesses, and volunteers also donate other significant items such as boxes, storage, and space for the event.

While many of the food items, time and other expenses are donated, the perishable items are purchased. We also purchase most of the non-perishable items needed to complete each basket in order to be able to help all those who depend on this effort.


**Pickled Eggs Society Club**




