## Addison Area Christmas Food Baskets

The Christmas season is definitely here and many in our community will need support in the way of food, and perhaps even help securing toys and gifts for their children. Many of our local organizations, churches, and individuals continue to work together to prepare food baskets for local families and individuals in need. Last year, we prepared 210 baskets and anticipate an even greater need this season. Each basket typically includes milk, eggs, butter, cheese, bread, potatoes, a turkey or ham, and other items to complete a few nice additional meals. Much of the non-perishable food items are donated through local food drives. Community members, churches, organizations, businesses, and volunteers also donate other significant items such as boxes, storage, and space for the event.

While many of the food items, time and other expenses are donated, the perishable items are purchased. We also purchase most of the non-perishable items needed to complete each basket in order to be able to help all those who depend on this effort.

## Knight Pride Community Wide: Veteran’s Day Celebration

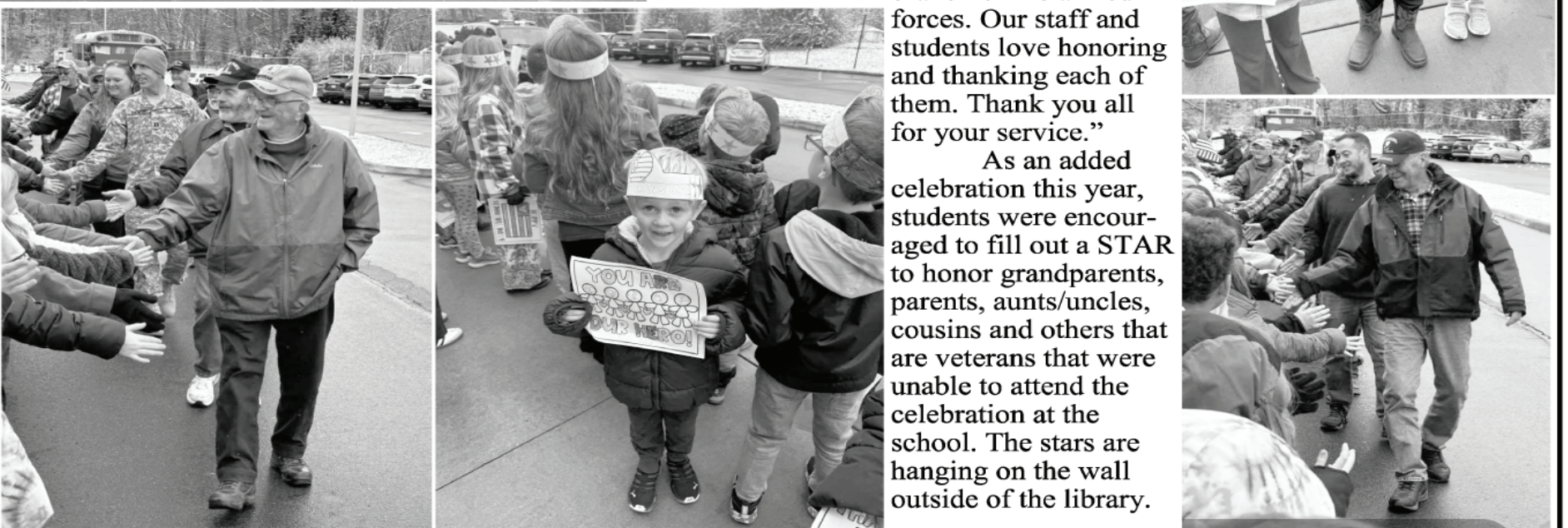

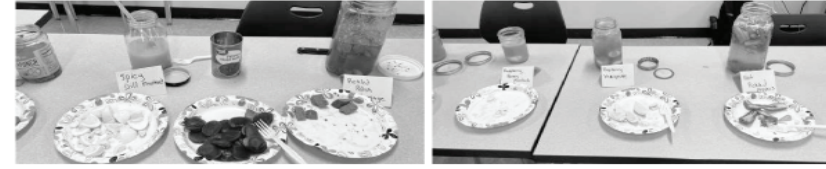


Pickled Eggs Society Club

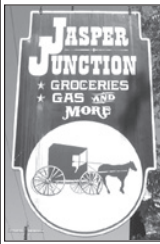
