The big mail-order stores sold plans for houses of all sizes, and many styles. You could, if you wished, also buy the whole set of precut materials to build the particular house of your dreams, from the catalog of your choice.

At 4 PM on Friday, December 5, Canisteo Historian Steve Cotton will provide an illustrated Steuben County Historical Society presentation on mail order homes, including specific examples still found in our area.

"People who wanted to become homeowners took advantage of the plans. So did developers – Glenn Curtiss built 'plan houses' in Hammondsport when his plant overflowed with three shifts of workers during World War I.

"With a hundred years and more gone by, many of the homes have been altered at least once. But look closely, and you can spot them along familiar streets and highways."

The presentation at Bath fire hall is free and open to the public.




Virginia M. “Ginny” Putnam




Valley: Letter F and G






