

The Young Hickory Community Restores the Steeple!

The board of the Ellis Grist youth center had been given a list from the insurance company of things that had to be fixed if we wanted to be covered. Several were things that we needed to do anyway, but one was the steeple! Yipe! As we explored options, we decided to ask the community about it, and we're glad we did! I walked into Pro Street Auto, and Lori greeted me pleasantly, listening carefully. She had Randy come out, and he immediately said, "What if a lift was donated?" I was very surprised. The lift was one of the most expensive parts of the job, and I stuttered out a thanks. "My brother, Dan, owns one for his construction company, and I'll start working on it," he said confidently. With a sliver of hope, I decided to use our annual charity 5K to help raise more necessary funds to do the project. The race day weather was awful, BUT it

didn't matter! The community had been donating all that week, and before anyone touched the starting line, we already had enough to get started. The weather that day might have been like the fingers of the grave, but the warm hearts of the community made it seem sunny and bright as I ran the race. Between other local businesses owned by the Cornell family and private donations, we almost had enough to maybe cover the project, so we proceeded on faith. As the project began, more community generosity overwhelmed us! The Car-Mul construction company donated a worker named Chase free of charge to run the lift, and we discovered that the gentleman was very skilled and hardworking! We hired Tim Stiff to head the project, and when he turned in his bill, it wasn't even minimum wage for all the time he put in! Larry Keegan was a huge help, meeting needs of the project constantly. Pro Street wanted the weather vane to be restored and despite time doing a number on it, they worked to restore it, with help from a friend of Larry Keegan. It looks great! Carl's construction company had two employees come over and contributed time between two jobs. We had an Eagle Scout, Carsyn Kemp, who was working on restoring parts of the building, spent hours picking up old shingles and nails, even though it was NOT part of his official project. Come spring, we intend to paint the upper area near the steeple and fix the louver door on the front. During the project, the community stressed the impact of the church through VBS or their regular services all the years it was open. The Christian youth center is still impacting the area, running Awana that runs during the school year for kids ages 4 years-old through sixth grade on Mondays and a youth group for teens 7th - 12th on Thursday, and it hosts a Christian young adult fellowship at times as well. Praise the Lord for his goodness and the wonderful people of the Young Hickory area! I hope God blesses you like he blessed the Ellis Grist Youth Center through the steeple project and other building projects!


