Bernard Edward "Ed" Stafford, 89, passed away peacefully at his home in Tuscarora, NY on March 18, 2026. Bernard was born on September 4, 1936, in Tuscarora, NY to his parents, John and Pearl Clark Stafford. He married the love of his life, Ruth Palmer, on June 29, 1968 in Tuscarora, NY. She predeceased him on March 22, 2016.



Ed graduated from Addison High School, Class of 1955. After the passing of his father, he took over the family dairy farm and spent many years working the land he loved. In 1986, he sold the dairy and transitioned to raising beef cattle until 2003. Even after selling his livestock, Ed continued baling and selling hay for several more years, as farming was not just his livelihood, it was part of who he was.

A man who felt most at home outdoors, Ed appreciated the simple gifts of country life. He was an avid hunter, fisherman, and gardener. In his later years, he especially enjoyed sitting on his porch watching his sons bailing the hay and the wildlife that passed through his yard. He took pride in the land around him and in the quiet beauty of the countryside.

Ed also served his community for many years as the Town Assessor and was always willing to lend a hand or share a story with neighbors and friends.

He is survived by his two sons: Brian Stafford of Pine City, Brandon (Andria) Stafford of Painted Post; his grandson: Ian Stafford; his sister, Shirley Petralia of Hilton, NY, along with several cousins, nieces, and nephews.

### Cold War Veterans' Exemption Amended

On March 9, 2026, at their regular monthly meeting, the Village of Addison Board of Trustees approved an amendment to Local Law #1 of 2018: A Local Law Granting the Cold War Tax Exemption to the Qualifying Residents of the Village of Addison pursuant to the New York State Real Property Tax Law 458-B. This exemption provides a basic property tax exemption of 15 percent of the assessed value to veterans who served during the Cold War period. The law also provides an additional exemption to disabled veterans, equal to one-half of their service-connected disability ratings. There is no time limit for this exemption. The exemption is limited to the primary residence of the veteran and is applicable only to general municipal taxes, not to school taxes or special district levies. Those who qualify must have served between September 2, 1945, and December 26, 1991, and are not currently receiving either the eligible funds or alternative veterans' exemptions. This local law has been filed with the New York State Department of State Division of Corporations, State Records, and Uniform Commercial Code.

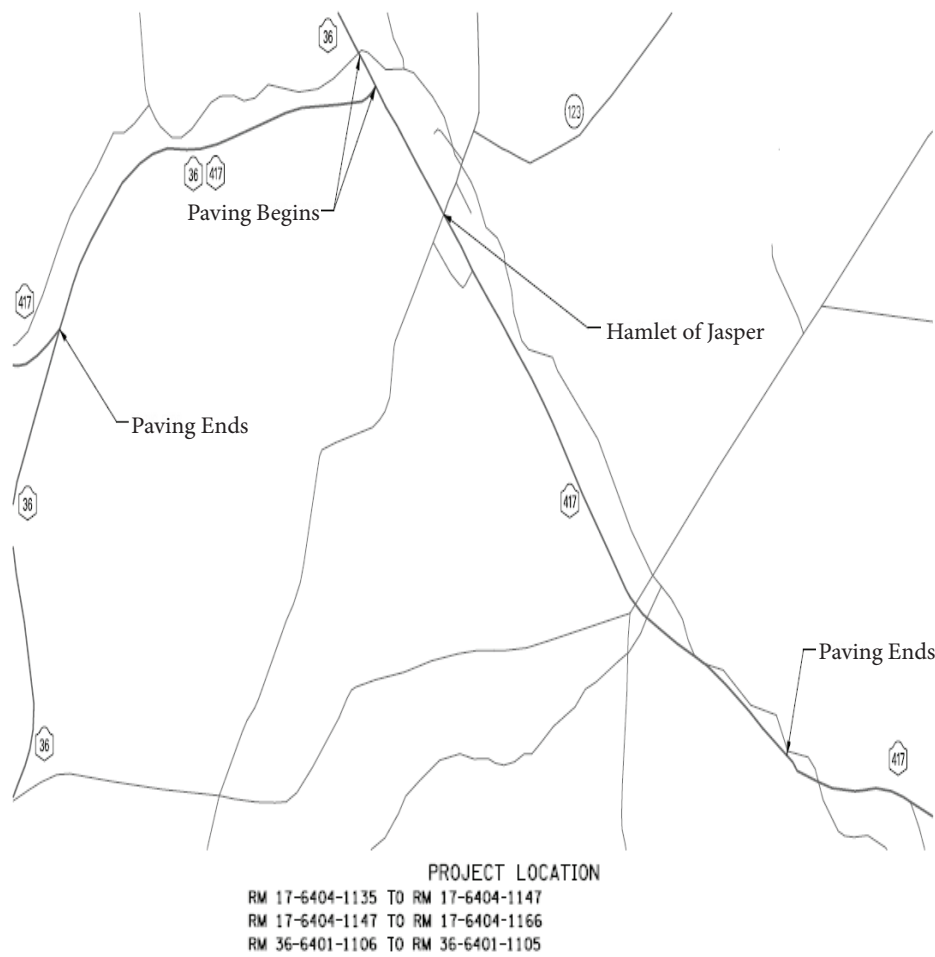

#### \$4M Paving & Pedestrian System Improvement Project, State Route 36, Jasper, NY

THE PROJECT seeks to enhance safety and accommodations for motorists, horse and buggies, pedestrians and bicyclists along State Route 36 and State Route 417 in Jasper. The project limits are as shown in the map below. Improvements will include adjusting drainage inlet frames and grates, pavement rehabilitation, widened shoulders, narrowed roadway lanes and installation of ADA-compliant sidewalks and ramps at the crossings at Troupsburg Central School, Dollar General and Jasper Junction. Other improvements will address pavement and drainage deficiencies. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2026 and be completed by fall of 2027. 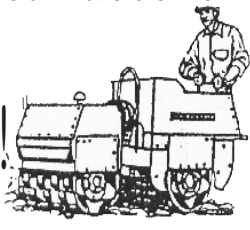
