## “Caring For Your Cemetery Day” Promotes Community Involvement

The NYS Department of State has declared Saturday, April 25 the 3rd Annual “Caring for Your Cemetery Day,” an initiative to raise awareness about the maintenance and preservation that cemeteries require.

Through a campaign with participating cemeteries, the department encourages volunteers to prepare for the spring season and Mother's Day visits. By engaging local communities, especially younger generations, the program seeks to recruit volunteers and trustees.

Secretary of State Robert J. Rodriguez said “cemeteries serve as historical repositories and places of reflection. Volunteering at local cemeteries provides a creative way to engage with the community and appreciate the unique stories and cultural heritage they hold”, he said.

Nathan Romagnola, president of the New York State Association of Cemeteries, said “volunteers are essential in preserving these sacred spaces for future generations”.

Clean-up day tasks may include cleaning up debris, removing downed branches and overgrowth, removing old decorations, planting flowers, scattering grass seeds, and other light tasks.

The department's Division of Cemeteries provides technical assistance and financial accounting to ensure that regulated cemeteries do not become a burden on their communities. The division also offers training workshops year-round on maintaining cemeteries, keeping financial records, and ensuring long-term viability.

**Not That You Asked..But Here's My Opinion Anyway**  
**Re: Dissolution of The Village of Addison**

I thought long and hard (1 second) about how to title this article. I chose a little quip to set the mood. You may ask yourself why I care about her opinion and that is okay. You don't have to read this, though I'd love for you to hear me out.

The current mood however could be described as dreary, dark, etc. I choose to look at it a different way. Albeit..I have to actively choose each day lately to do so. I choose to look at this talk of dissolution as an opportunity for residents to reconnect with their village, their neighbors, their elected representatives, and to see its beauty as it currently is.

Let me start by expressing my distaste for the conversation about the dissolution of our village. I don't know why but it simply doesn't sit well with me.

This is kind of crazy, since 26 years ago, I couldn't wait to get out of this place. Life took me many places and some were better than others.

Ultimately in 2019, due to my mom falling ill and needing some extra help, my husband and I moved back to our hometown. We quickly grew attached to everything that is Addison. There simply is no place quite like it.

Nowhere that we have lived has had a community as connected as this one.

A little back story, my mother (God rest her soul), Toni Heidrich-Shorthouse, loved Addison. She grew up here, 1 of 7 kids, the Heidrich's of Cowley Hill Rd. Her roots were deep here. While I was growing up she tried her darndest to show me through example, a life of civic duty and pride in one's hometown. I suppose I did take it all in and learn from her after I grew up and didn't "know it all" as teenagers and young adults do. Unfortunately, it just didn't become clear until she passed in 2021.

Still unsure of how to navigate waters that didn't include my mom I was one day in 2022 standing on my front porch reading an article in The Addison Post from Eva Sue Cunningham looking for residents to join the Planning Board. I had this weird feeling that my mom was there at that moment, pushing me. Helping me navigate. After all, a life of service is a life well lived. That was 4 years ago. Since I was appointed to the planning board all those years ago, I have since been a part of a variety of local organizations and boards.

My point is, I suppose, is that while my identity isn't tied to the village, it is tied to my mother, who I know none of this would sit well with. I have attended dare I say most board meetings since 2022. I have sat through 5 different boards to this point. I have learned things that are good and bad about politics and the human condition. *Continued next week.*

## Robert “Bob” Morena

Robert “Bob” Morena, husband, father, scientist, mentor, neighbor, and devoted farmer, passed away unexpectedly on March 28, 2026, at his farm in Caton, NY. He was 80 years old.

Bob was born on October 21, 1945, in Elizabeth, NJ, and raised in the nearby city of Linden. He graduated from Rutgers University with a degree in ceramics and went on to earn a master’s degree in ceramic engineering from Ohio State University. A proponent of peace, he became active in the anti-war movements of the late 1960s and early 1970s and would later eagerly regale others with stories of various protests in which he participated. This reflected a man who refused to separate his convictions from his life. He worked as a research ceramist in Baltimore, MD, then set that aside to teach high school math and science, first in Chicago as a VISTA Volunteer and then in Washington, D.C. It was during his time in Washington that he and a close-knit group of friends shared a communal home they affectionately called the “Mushroom House.” Those years reflected the spirit of the time: idealism, creativity, laughter, and deep friendship. The bonds formed there lasted a lifetime, with several reunions over the years. It was also in Washington, through Teacher Corps at Howard University, that he met the love of his life, Marie, at a party. From that first meeting they were inseparable. After a stint as a research engineer in Curwensville, PA, he enrolled at Virginia Tech in 1978, where he completed his doctorate in glass ceramics and chemistry. He dedicated his dissertation to Marie for her support, and, in his words, “more important, for showing me that indeed the robin does have two songs (‘cheerio-cheerio’, and ‘hey-baby, hey-baby’).”



It was living in the bucolic Virginia countryside outside Blacksburg, in the community of Catawba, that Bob and Marie found what would become the spiritual home of their marriage. Neighbors and local farmers took them in and taught them to tend the land, raise animals, and live with intention. Those friendships, and that way of life, never left either of them.

Bob accepted a position at Corning Incorporated’s Sullivan Park research facility in western New York, beginning a career of 34 years. He rose to the level of Senior Research Scientist, authoring numerous publications and 120 patents. Among his most lasting professional contributions was his seminal role in the development of frit, a critical ingredient of Corning’s Gorilla Glass. He was known throughout his career as a loyal mentor and someone who could make the most complex science accessible to anyone. Marie worked alongside him at Sullivan Park as a biochemist. They had a standing lunch date every day.

Marie preceded him in death in January 2023, after 44 years of marriage. Over the course of their time together, Bob and Marie developed a passion and palate for fine wine and trips to Europe. They quickly became an established and cherished part of the Caton community. The farm had always been theirs, and after Marie passed it became Bob’s way of staying close to everything they had built. He tended the sheep she had helped deliver and raise, kept the land she had gardened, and carried forward the life they had chosen together. In her memory, and in the spirit of the spinner’s guild she had loved, he endowed an award to support the fiber arts community that had been part of their world on that farm.

In the years following Marie’s passing, Bob found partnership and joy in his friendship with Sally Murphy of Lindley, NY, whose companionship brightened his later years. Sally inspired him to cook, and he took to it with the same gusto he brought to everything else, working his way through Italian cookbooks and recipes with contagious enthusiasm. The two traveled to Italy together in fall 2025.

Bob had come a long way from suburban New Jersey. What began as a young man’s experiment in country living in Virginia’s Blue Ridge Mountains became, by the end of his life, something genuine: a gentleman farmer in the fullest sense of the phrase. The farm in Caton had been home over the years to countless cows, pigs, goats, ducks, turkeys, chickens, geese, and sheep. Of these, the sheep, chickens, and his white geese were ever present on the farm. He grew vegetables, pulled lambs, made hay, repaired fences, welcomed neighbors, and refused every suggestion to slow down or seek assistance elsewhere. The farm gave him purpose and impetus, which he returned in full.

His friendships, from the Mushroom House to Sullivan Park to the neighbors who became his community in Caton, were built on the same qualities he brought to everything else: quick wit, candid opinions, and unwavering loyalty. He meant the world to the people around him, and they to him.

Bob is survived by his son, Matt, and his wife, Lindsay, of Newport News, VA; his daughter, Lilly, of Burlington, VT; his granddaughters, Finley and Addilyn; his sister, Mary, and her husband, Don, of Holmdel, NJ; his companion, Sally, of Lindley, NY; close friends, Charlene and Robert, of Corning, NY; and his loyal border collie, Buster. He was preceded in death by his wife and partner of fifty years, Marie Bryhan; his sister, Phyllis Frazier; and a lifetime of animals he tended with the same care he gave to everything he loved.

A Memorial Service for Bob is planned for a future date this coming Spring. In lieu of flowers, the family welcomes contributions to the Finger Lakes SPCA, Planned Parenthood, or simply an afternoon spent outside.

The District Clerk must then receive the military voter's military ballot by mail or in person not later than 5:00p.m. on the day of the vote.
