Lynn is survived by her four children: her son, Frank Haftl of Cameron NY, and her daughters Judy Haftl of

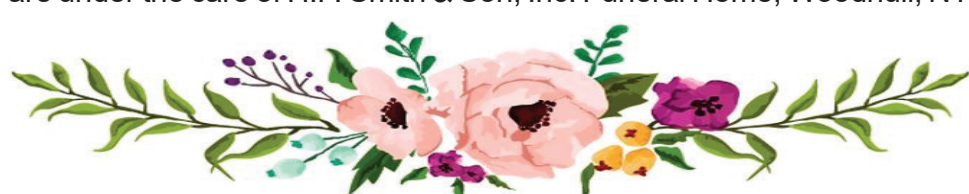

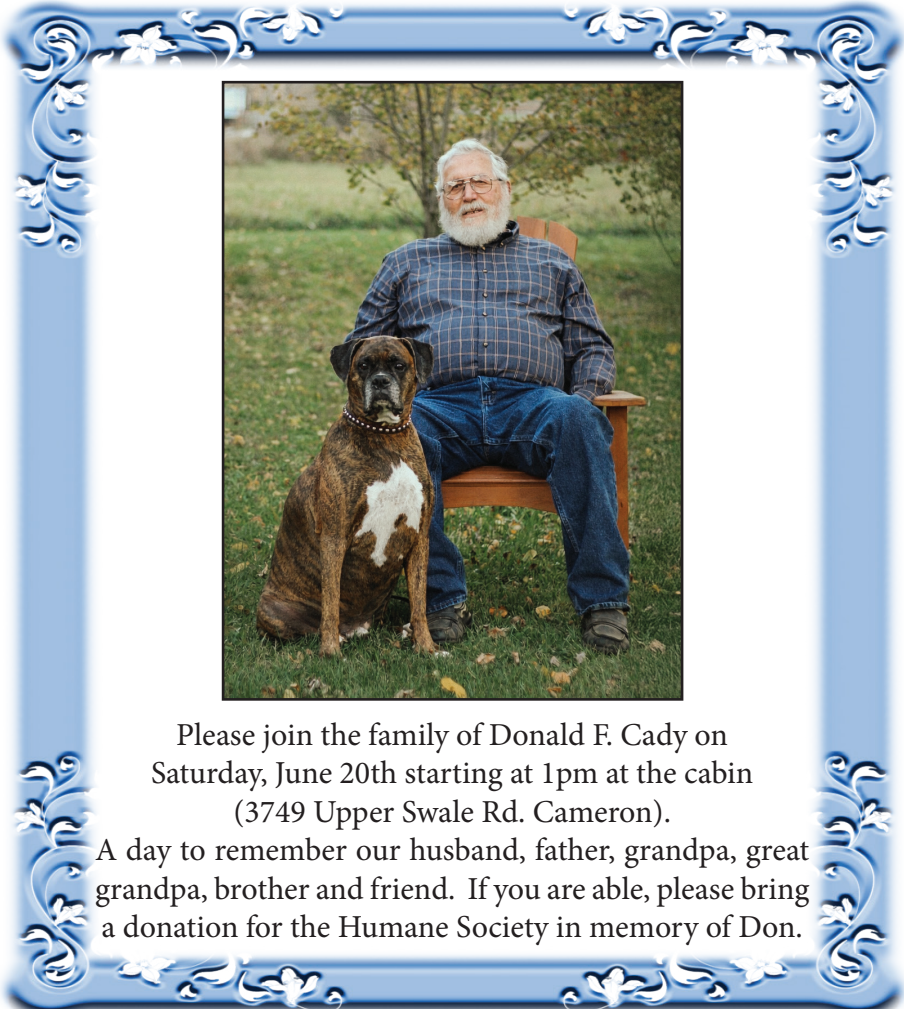

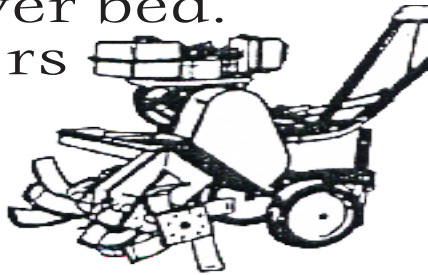
