

### Retired Army Major General Thomas Joseph Flynn (RET)

Retired Army Major General Thomas Joseph Flynn (RET), a resident of Ellicott City, Maryland and Addison, New York passed away peacefully on June 22, 2025.

Born in Corning, NY, November 2, 1930, he grew up in nearby Addison, NY. He graduated from Addison Central School in 1948. He was proud of his high school years, where he played baseball, basketball, and touch football. He was also very proud of his own pony,

horse and cow. He graduated from Saint Michael's College at the University of Toronto in 1952. His distinguished Army career began after graduation when he enlisted as a Private in the Army Security Agency (ASA). He trained as a Morse code interceptor, attended the Infantry Officer Candidate School, and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant, rising to the rank of Major General.

Major General Flynn served twelve years overseas including a tour in Vietnam, where he commanded the Army's 175th Radio Research Unit at Bien Hoa. He served in Germany twice, for a total of seven years where he commanded Field Station Augsburg (1976-1978), at that time, the largest Army Intelligence Station. He also served in Korea, Hawaii, Japan, and Shemya, Alaska. His assignments in the US included multiple assignments in Virginia, including the Pentagon, four times at Ft. Devens, MA, Camp Wolters TX, and the National Security Agency at Ft. Meade, MD. Following his promotion to Brigadier General, he was assigned as Deputy Commanding General of the US Army Intelligence and Security Command at Arlington Hall Station, VA.

His military education included the Army Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, KS, the Air War College at Maxwell Air Force Base, AL and the Senior Executive Course at Harvard University. His decorations include the Distinguished Service Medal, the Legion of Merit with four oak leaf clusters, the Bronze Star, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Army Commendation Medal, and other service medals. He

was twice awarded the Distinguished Intelligence Medal by the Director of the CIA, the nation's highest intelligence medal. While he enlisted as a Private, his final assignment in the military culminated as the Chief of Staff of the National Security Agency at Fort Meade, MD. Upon retirement in February 1988, he later served as Chairman of the US Signal Intelligence Committee under the direction of the Central Intelligence Agency and the National Security Agency.

Following full retirement he was active in the Ft. Meade Ski Club, Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church, enjoyed traveling, gardening, wood working and especially spending time with his family.

His family and friends will miss his loving and caring attitude, his sense of humor, and his dedication to his wife of 67 years, family, friends, soldiers, and their families. His motto was, "I care." His college and teacher motto of: "Teach me goodness, discipline, and knowledge," was how he hoped he lived his life.

Major General Thomas J. Flynn was preceded in death by his parents, Frank and Kathryn Flynn of Addison, NY, his brother Dr. John Flynn, and his sister Anne Murphy.

He is survived by his wife, Alice (Duclos) of Worcester, MA, the love of his life; five children Michael (Susan) of Black Mountain, NC, Lisa Heard of Woodbridge, VA, Mary (Monte) Malone of Ellicott City, MD, Timothy (Sheila) of Fayetteville, NC, Mark (Dawn) of Salt Lake City, UT; thirteen grandchildren: Addison and Mallory Flynn; Melissa, Lauren and Ally Heard; Amanda (Tyrone Saterfield) and Matthew Malone; Erin, William, Kelly and Meghan Flynn; Hannah and Abbey Flynn; and two great grandchildren, Avery Heard and Marleigh Saterfield. A funeral mass will be held July 1, 2025 at 11:00 A.M. at Our Lady Of Perpetual Help, 4795 Ilchester Rd, Ellicott City, MD 21043.



### **Request for Environmental Testing Services 2025 CDBG Program – Housing Rehabilitation**

The Town of Thurston is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide Environmental Testing services to assist with implementing its recently approved Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding award for Housing Rehabilitation activities. The Town will contract for these services to be provided over a 24-month period and anticipates up to 5 single-family houses will be rehabilitated through the CDBG program.

Specific services being requested include:

- 1. Lead-based paint risk assessments for all rehabilitation projects.
- 2. Lead-based paint clearance testing for all rehabilitation projects.
- 3. Asbestos survey to determine if any asbestos-containing materials (ACM) will be disturbed as part of the program activities.
- 4. Radon testing for all rehabilitation projects.

Please note that the Town and its grant administration consultant, LaBella Associates, will provide information regarding the expected work items to be completed for each of the houses to be selected for rehabilitation assistance. LaBella staff can also assist with scheduling the assessments and testing on the selected properties.

If you are interested in conducting the environmental testing services described above, please submit a proposal detailing your firm's qualifications and experience in providing environmental testing services for other housing rehabilitation or similar programs. All proposals should include a detailed scope of work that describes the level of effort and cost estimates to provide the testing, as well as familiarity with the applicable testing regulations and requirements. The staff person to be assigned as project manager should be identified in your proposal as well as resumes of any key staff involved. Relevant staff should be available in Thurston to conduct the required in-person testing. The Town will expect the consultant to focus on regulation compliance, completion of reports and test results in a timely manner and maintaining communications to carry out program responsibilities. The Town will make its selection based on the following criteria:

- Successful experience (past performance)
- Technical capability and financial resources
- (qualifications of personnel and financial stability of respondent organization)
- Availability of staff resources (commitment
- of personnel to the project)
- Cost

#### Dear Editor,

People have been shocked by the increase in their electric bills from SREC. But they have no idea how bad it will get. You see SREC has a contract for a fixed maximum amount of power from NYPA and after that the extra power cost, PEAK POWER, is unknown until they get the bill. In winter at times of peak demand, like early morning when people turn up their electric heat and in the evening, they exceed the contract power. They told me that this past winter instead of about 3 cents per KWH they found it was about 10 cents after they bought it. So to ease the burden on the electric heat customers they only charged 1 cent extra and will do that through November. So they in effect subsidized the customers that caused the increased costs spreading it to everyone when people are not using electric heat. To put it layman's terms it is like pulling up to the gas pump and getting 10 gallons of gas at \$3 a gallon and then having the pump price go dark while you finish filling the tank and finding you were charged \$10 a gallon and putting the extra charge on the credit card and paying interest for 10 months. The real danger is that due to the GREEN NEW DEAL they are shutting down many more coal plants and replacing them with solar. Guess what solar does not produce at night when the peak demand hits. It does not produce on short winter days and when it is cloudy! Thus there will be little peak power available when SREC needs it to supply electric heat customers and they could easily find it costs not 10 cents but 10 DOLLARS for that power! I have seen peak power costs exceed \$1,000 a KWH. In the Texas freeze people had these kinds of power contracts and received \$1,000 a day electric bills. This is how the California electric utilities went bankrupt in the ENRON PEAK POWER SCANDAL.

SREC is planning to **RENT** expensive batteries to store power at off peak times and supply it at peak times. There are two problems with this plan. 1, batteries are only about 90% efficient and thus they will consume 10 KWH for every 9 KWH they supply. Second there is no guarantee that there will be enough off peak power to recharge the batteries but YOU will have to pay the rent even if they save nothing. It is like putting 10 gallons of gas in the truck and then renting an extra tank so you can stock up when there is a sale but having no assurance there will be a sale.

Then you have the \$30 meter charge which INCENTIVISES using more power! If you use 100 KWH @ \$0.03 the real cost with the meter charge is \$3.00 per KWH plus \$30 or \$0.33 per KWH BUT if you use 1,000 KWH at \$0.03 the real cost is \$30 plus the meter charge \$30 or \$60 or 0.06 per KWH. At a time when we do not have enough generating power and consumption is exploding you need to incentivise conservation by making power cost more the more of it you use. Thus the more electric heat you use the cheaper it is and other people pay for it for you.

The only hope the customers of SREC have of affording their bills is stopping the use of the extra power by charging for both demand and time of day use at the time of year it is used. They could use their smart meter to shut off electric heat in homes at times of peak demand. They may have to consider rolling blackouts. Paying people with standby generators to allow themselves to be shut off at times of peak demand. Or paying people without standby generators to have a few hours a day without power.

NY State's Governor is guaranteeing cheap power to chip producers and data centers and that means peak power prices are going to explode as NY State sends the cheap SUBSIDIZED peak power to them and charges you for the most expensive power. If SREC continues as they are going you can look forward to your \$100 electric bill being \$1,000 or MUCH MORE! The Bible tells us there is nothing new under the sun, nothing that will happen that has not happened before and this is exactly what happened in the City where they changed the coal plants to what was then cheap oil and then had the price of #6 high sulphur oil go from 6 cents to ONE DOLLAR overnight.




