

Addison Area Food Pantry Loses Freezer But Doesn't Lose Hope

On 6/27 during a routine check on the pantry, it was found that our small freezer had guit working and so all of its contents had gone bad. To see us lose all of that food was devastating. All I could think was all of the families that would potentially go without.

The very next day was our normal scheduled pantry day and I didn't know how we were going to get the mess cleaned up, the smell gone, and still be able to operate for the community within less than 24 hours. Thankfully Abagail Freeman and Lilly Radka stepped up and got the worst part of it cleaned up and the food thrown out.

I posted about our predicament on the Pantry's Facebook page and I was not prepared for the generosity that was shown!

By the next morning Hope and Jeff Wheaton reached out to me and offered to purchase the pantry a new stand up freezer! They came right down to the pantry, took measurements and off they went to the store to get it! Scott Towner donated \$500, Tina and Jr Proulx \$100, and even my wonderful neighbors the Doty's left money on my door to help offset the cost of the food we lost. I cannot express how much we appreciate them!

My father, Kevin Shorthouse, Diane Hubbard, Angela and Morgan Leach, all helped with more of the clean up that was needed prior to the new freezer coming and without every single one of them we never would have been able to be open for people to access food that day. Many thanks go to Lori Bennett, Amie Sorel, Kathy Rapisarda for being there to help the community members still get access to food amidst the clean-up going on!

It never ceases to amaze me how such a small village can come together in such a monumental way. Thank you to everyone for continuing to support the pantry in all the ways you do. Even if it's sharing our Facebook page or telling someone you know about us. Every bit helps us to be able continue to serve the public.



Saturday (July 5) started out to be a beautiful day as we had a wedding to attend in the afternoon but the morning turned out to be a nightmare. A horseshoe from a passing Amish buggy came loose and crashed through one of our windows on Front Street and into the house. The damage to the window was bad enough but the damage to the interior of the house was worse. Lots of glassware was destroyed and we are still vacuuming broken glass in the carpets.

I am not writing this letter expecting to be reimbursed for damages as I have no idea whose horse it was or how much total damages will be . I am writing to ask the Amish community to please check your horse for loose shoes before coming to town and traveling Front Street. I truly believe that if it had hit me or my wife or one of our cats we would have been severely wounded or possibly killed. This was not the first time that this has happened. A few years ago a horseshoe got wedged in the wooden slats on our front porch. Luckily it did not hit the house.
