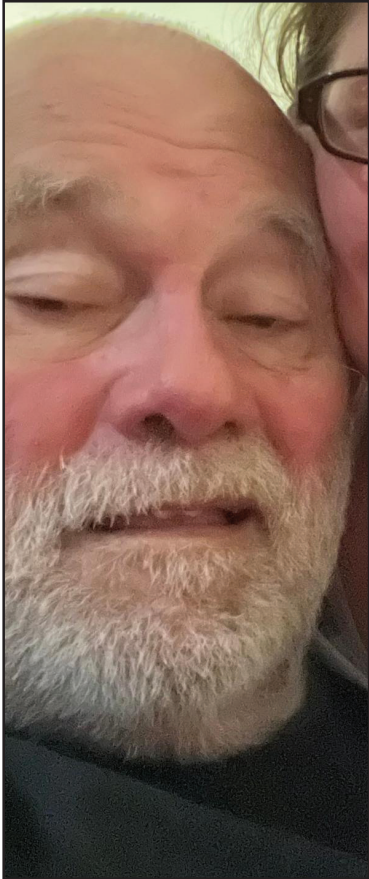

At its meeting on July 13, 2026, the Village of Addison Board of Trustees unanimously voted to end the Dissolution Study process. 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EARLY NOTICE AND PUBLIC REVIEW OF PROPOSED ACTIVITY LOCATED IN A 100-YEAR FLOODPLAIN

To: All interested Agencies, Groups and Individuals, including the Steuben County Public Works Department, NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, NYS Office of Community Renewal, NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets, NYS Department of Health, NYS Department of Transportation, NYS Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

This is to give notice that the Town of West Union has conducted an evaluation as required by Executive Order 11988 and 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management, to determine the potential affect that its activity in the floodplain and wetland will have on the human environment for the Town of West Union-Rexville Water System Improvements Project.

The proposed project involves the replacement of water main along NY State Highway 248, Pleasant Avenue, and County Road 117, reconditioning of existing groundwater wells near the intersection of Pleasant Avenue and NY State Highway 248 and conversion of existing pump units to pitless arrangements, demolition of the existing water treatment building and construction of a new well building at the existing water treatment facility at the intersection of Pleasant Avenue and NY State Highway 248. The project area is located within the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) mapped 100-year floodplain of Tributary 17 of Bennett Creek. Floodplains provide a number of ecological functions, including flood protection, improved water quality, and wildlife habitat. The proposed replacement water main along NY State Highway 248 intersects the mapped floodplain. The water main will be located underground, and all temporarily disturbed areas will be restored to their pre-construction grades and stabilized after water main installation is complete. Therefore, no permanent impacts to floodplains will result from the project. The total area of the FEMA-mapped 100-year floodplain within the project area is approximately 0.2 acres. The project will result in less than 0.1 acre of temporary disturbance within the mapped 100-year floodplain associated with water main replacement. The proposed project is located along NY State Highway 248, Pleasant Avenue, and County Road 117 in the Town of West Union, Steuben County, New York.

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in floodplains and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational tool. The dissemination of information about floodplains can facilitate and enhance Federal efforts to reduce the risks associated with the occupancy and modification of these special areas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the Federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in floodplain, it must inform those who may be put at greater or continued risk.
