Duane was predeceased by his father, Glen Lewis on February 28, 2020.

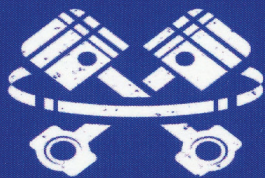
