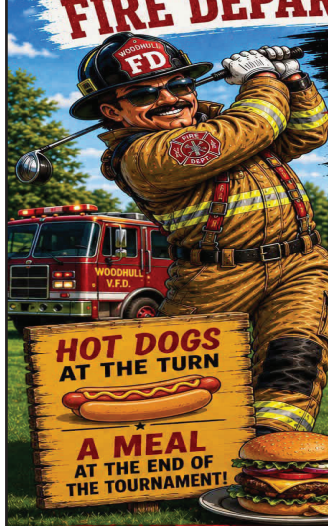
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## Susan Jane Elizabeth Pavin Tranchida

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### Dear Editor

A one-time-only special screening of The Sludge War is coming to Steuben County, August 8th at 4:00pm in the High School of Campbell NY.

The Sludge War is a five-year investigative documentary that begins when a woman discovers that the community she moved into was built on land where sewage sludge had been buried. What begins as a personal search for answers expands into a national investigation spanning seven states, following families and farmers whose lives have been upended by this practice.

The film features interviews with some of the most respected scientists in the field, along with rare insider accounts.

Through never-before-seen depositions, internal memos, and congressional documents, the film reveals how sewage sludge came to be accepted as safe and entrenched across American farmland. It exposes how scientific warnings were repeatedly ignored and how responsibility was shifted onto communities that were left to bear the consequences.

By bringing the history, science, and evidence together in one place, the film provides a powerful resource for understanding the issue and for communities facing the same fight to connect and protect their health and their homes.

The evening will include a red carpet, followed by the 80-minute film. After the screening, there will be a Q&A with the director, as well as an opportunity for Steuben County community members to speak about their own experiences.

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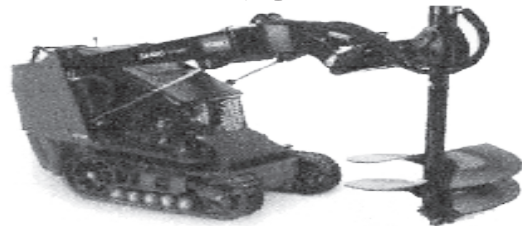
