To the Editor:

The Steuben County Legislature, at its July 24th meeting authorized the Steuben County Sheriff to install license plate reader equipment within the geographical jurisdiction of the county of Steuben, for “law enforcement purposes” only within the State Right of Way along State Routes 36, 63, 15, 21, 53, 54, 54A, 226, 414, 352, 961Q, 417, 415, 961J, 248, and 225, located in the Towns of Dansville, Wayland Cohocton, Prattsburgh, Urbana, Wayne, Bradford, Hornby, Corning, Erwin, Campbell, Bath, Hornellsville, Avoca, Addison, Troupsburg, West Union, Greenwood, Jasper and Caton, all in Steuben County.

These License Plate Readers, also known as Automated license plate recognition(ALPR) systems are most often mounted on road signs, and bridges. The information captured by the readers – including license plate number, date, time, and location of every scan, thousands of plates per minute, are sometimes pooled into regional sharing systems.

This information can be shared among local, statewide or even national databases. The reason that the Sheriff’s department wanted installation of these readers is to cut crime; to catch drug dealers, car thieves, crime in action.

Unfortunately, along with tracking the bad guys, the cameras are also tracking us, private citizens going about our daily lives. Remember Big Brother watching you – well, he’s here now!

There have been many instances of abuse of the cameras, tracking ex-girlfriends, tracking random people for ICE, tracking women crossing state lines to obtain procedures illegal in their state.

Several nearby municipalities have canceled the use of the ALPR cameras. Syracuse dropped Flock after leaning the city had accidentally made its data available nationwide and it was accessed by U.S. Customs and Border Protection. Ithaca and Tomkins County have also ended the use of Flock cameras. (WSKG 7/31/2026)

I feel that residents of Steuben County should have some input as to whether or not the Sheriff/County should be installing these cameras and at what cost. Before the final dotted line is signed, the County Legislature should hold a hearing and allow Steuben residents to voice their opinions.

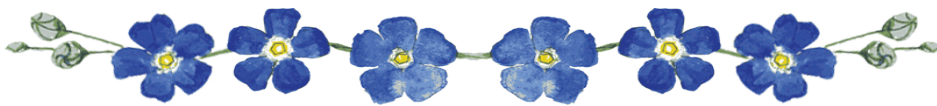
