IN ATTENDANCE: Mayor Ed Soporowski, Trustees Lorne Hults, Bo Graham, Tara Watson, and Village Clerk/Treasurer Donna Taylor. Trustee Dennis Rattay was marked as absent. **REVIEW OF RESOLUTION 2-2025A**

Mayor Soporowski announced that the purpose of this meeting is to amend Resolution No.

2-2025, which was

approved on July 14, 2025, during the Village of Addison Regular Board meeting. The original resolution contained inaccuracies concerning the dissolution proceedings, making it essential to correct the public record.

This amendment aims to ensure clarity, transparency, and alignment with the Village's actual intent and legal obligations.

Therefore, it is resolved that the Village of Addison Board of Trustees hereby rescinds and replaces Resolution 2-2025 with Resolution 2-2025A. The Board approved the new resolution with a vote of 4-0-1.

APPROVAL OF PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING SERVICES

To support the Village of Addison during the ongoing Board-Initiated Village Dissolution process, the Board of Trustees received two (2) Requests for Qualifications from Consultant Groups that specialize in these services. With a vote of 4-0-1, the Board of Trustees approved entering into a partnership with Laberge Group to conduct the study.
